# World Bible School

Tim Yeager, World Bible School's Chief Information Officer, reports that March was one of the highest counts of adoptions made. That means that many <u>seekers</u> of Biblical truth were selected by teachers to be their students. The <u>student board</u> from where they're selected has almost forty seekers every morning. The <u>Sower's</u> work is done almost daily whether online, postal or smart phone. There are hundreds of baptisms each month.

A follow-up system is in place to track the progress of those who request baptism into Christ, It may reflect "pending" until a WBS contact in a country as phoned or personally met the student. It may say "finished" when we have a new brother or sister in the Lord. Sometimes pictures of baptisms are available for rejoicing. The WBS curriculum includes spiritual growth after baptism. Membership in a congregation is strongly encouraged for fellowship, worship and further studies.
