### From the Couch

**Busy and Happy in God’s Work.** A congregation that is actively serving others has little time to argue, fuzz, and divide. We are grateful for the many servants who love the Lord. To find your niche of service, you will need to try several things before you learn how God had “gifted” you. Some have great people skills. Others are talented in communicating the gospel to others. If we do not use what God has given to us to serve others, He will take that ability away (Matthew 25:28-29).

We have had a very busy summer: Camp Cornerstone, Vacation Bible School, and Bible Lands Museum—in addition to all the other ministries of the church that are numerous. If you are looking for ways to serve, find an active Christian and ask them how you might get involved.

**School of Evangelism Coming to White Bluff.** On September 28-30, Rob Whitaker will be with us to teach us a method of leading others to Christ. He will speak three times on Sunday the 28<sup>th</sup>, then once each that Monday (29<sup>th</sup>) and Tuesday (30<sup>th</sup>). Do you have friends or loved ones that do not know Christ? Would you like to know a way you could approach them with the gospel? Plan now to be a part of every presentation by brother Rob Whitaker.

**Do Your Own Thinking.** How much has the world influenced your thinking? Every time you watch TV, or a video on your computer or smart phone, others are influencing how you are thinking. However, when you read the Bible and think about what you read, God can shape your thinking. Do you have a Christian worldview? A worldview is a lens through which you interpret the information feeding into your mind. We can have a Christian worldview only if we have developed biblical values about God, mankind, sin, redemption, service, the church, the world, and eternity.

Paul said in 1 Thess. 5:21, “test everything. Hold fast to what is good.” He told Timothy, “Until I come, devote yourself to the public reading of Scripture, to exhortation, to teaching...Practice these things, immerse yourself in them, so that all may see your progress” (1 Timothy 4:13,15). Measure everything you see, read, or hear by the only infallible standard God has given us—the Bible.
