

WHAT A SAVIOR

Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him. (Rom. 5:9)

Three great truths are taught in this verse. One is the reality of God's wrath. Though some attempt to deny it, God's wrath is very real. If it were not, there would be no need for us to be saved from it.

A second truth is that humans are not capable of rescuing themselves from His wrath. Because of sin, all have been given a death sentence (Romans 3:23; 6:23). We are absolutely powerless to do anything about that. The humblest have often said, "I don't feel like I am good enough to go to heaven." That is true, none of us, on our own, are good enough. We never will be.

A third truth is equally evident. We are made fit for Heaven by the blood of Christ. The simplest definition of "justified" is "declared not guilty." We are declared "not guilty," not because we have not sinned, but because Jesus bore the penalty for us. His blood was shed to save us from the wrath of God.

A final truth is made clear; Jesus is a great Savior. He, alone, can save us from God's wrath. Willingly and without any hesitation, He left heaven, came to earth, and died on a cross to do what we could not do for ourselves.

Philip Bliss said it in a beautiful way. "Man of sorrows, what a name For the Son of God who came, ruined sinners to reclaim! Hallelujah! What a Savior."


