## IF RICHES INCREASE

The very possibility of increasing riches sounds wonderful, doesn't it? How most of us would welcome a windfall of wealth. There would be so many things to do....if only we had the money. However, we hardly ever pause to ponder the snares that may beset us.

**If riches increase, don't set your heart on them!** One can be wealthy on Wednesday and flat on Friday. More than one man has learned the hard lesson that "riches certainly make themselves wings" (Prov. 23:5). A future which depends solely on stocks and bonds is as uncertain as the weather. Thus the psalmist said, "My soul, wait thou only upon God" (Ps. 63:5).

**If riches increase, don't forget God!** The terrible tendency for a person of many possessions is to say, "Look what I've done." The truth of the matter is, "God hath given riches and wealth, and hath given him power to eat thereof, and to take his portion, and to rejoice in his labor, this is the gift of God" (Eccl. 5:19). If riches increase the first question should be: "What shall I render unto the Lord for all His benefits toward me?" You are not a *self-made* man. Don't forget Him who gave you your fortune.

**If riches increase, don't forget your fellow man!** Guard carefully against the thought: "Soul, thou hast much goods laid up for many years; take thine ease, eat, drink, and be merry." This has been the undoing of more than one man. Are there no poor, no needy, no orphans to support? Can you not see their tears and hear their sighs? Remember! There was certain rich man who had it made.... yet neglected Lazarus at his own gate. If you live only for your own comfort Jesus warns, ".... ye have received your consolation (Luke 6:24).

There is nothing wrong with *prospering* in life, but there is a *danger* involved. Riches can steal your heart if you let them.

### Grounded in Truth

Truth is constant. Truth does not vary from one person to the next and it does not change with the circumstance. Truth is like a tree with deep roots. The winds of change may blow strong against it but that tree does not move an inch and when the storm passes by the tree is still there. The Lord's great desire for the church is that we "no longer be children tossed to and fro and carried about by every wind of doctrine;" but that we would be so grounded in the truth that we would remain steadfast when the winds of change pass by. How do we get those deep roots? There are two ways the truth of God's word takes root in the believer.

First, God "gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers. . .that we should no longer be tossed to and fro..." (Ephesians 4:1 1-15). In other words God sat up a teaching program for the church so each member could be grounded in truth.

Second, God commands each member to study for ourselves. We must study to show ourselves approved unto God (2 Timothy 2:15).

Spiritual roots grow deep when personal desire drives us to study and when we spend time with godly teachers of His word (Psalm 1:1-6). We hope to see you in Bible class each week.
