

From the Couch

Preaching the Gospel. In the last few days, it was my privilege to preach on Jan. 30 at the East Ridge Church of Christ in Chattanooga, and on Feb. 9 at the Freed-Hardeman Univ. Lectureship. On April 3-6 I will be with the McEwen Church for a Gospel Meeting and later, on April 26, I will be speaking at the Southeast Institute of Biblical Studies Lectureship in Knoxville.

Power in Prayer. The early church prayed diligently, fervently, in full confidence that God heard them. One early Christian, Tertullian (AD 155-220) wrote on the power of prayer.

Prayer is the spiritual offering that abolished the ancient [animal] sacrifices...Prayer put to flight the armies of the enemy...[It] turns aside the wrath of God, is concerned for its enemies, makes supplication for persecutors...Prayer alone conquers God...Prayer forgives sins, it drives back temptations, quenches persecutions, strengthens the weak-hearted...brings home the wayfarers, stills the waves, confounds the robbers, feeds the poor, rules the rich, lifts up the fallen, supports the unstable...Angels pray too. All of them [Treatise on Prayer].

Pray without ceasing (1 Thess. 5:17).

- Stay Positive in a negative world; concentrate on the good things.
- Give people more than they expect, cheerfully (Phil. 1:21).
- ◆ Don't let a little dispute injure a great friendship (Prov. 27:10)
- ♦ When you say, "I'm sorry," look the person in the eye.
- ◆ Do an anonymous kindness each day (Eph. 4:32)
- When you make a mistake, take immediate steps to correct it.
- In disagreements, do no name-calling, threats, or bringing up ancient history.
