### Words from Ethan.....

C.S. Lewis said, "You may forget that you are at every moment totally dependent on God." These words help bring to life the desperation of David in Psalm 6. David expresses his vulnerability with God. He knows what is due to him because of his rebellion and sin against God. This king of God's people deserved to be dethroned, to be judged for his sins, and to be punished with an eternal death, and David knew this. The consequence of his sin is for God to pour his wrath and anger on him, and this has now become a reality to him. As guilt and fear slipped into his heart, so did understanding of the covenant, which he broke with the One who has never broken a covenant.

God does not look at us as lost. He looks at each of us with unimaginable grace, compassion, and love as a sinner. We are dependent on God for this grace, but if we view God as angry with us and one who is ready to punish us, we will never step into God's glorious grace. God is a rescuer, a savior because of faithful love, and one who will give us power to fight the darkness. Psalm 6 shows us the true attributes of God and not the deception that Satan tries to feed us. David knew that in order to defeat darkness and overcome the lies that Satan slips into our minds, our dependence needed to be on what was solid. In the close of this passage, David says, "...the Lord accepts my prayer" (Psalms 6:9). God accepts our prayers, and whatever temptation or guilt is fighting against us is to be in submission to this very fact. God is all powerful and all controlling. When we open our eyes to see what God is actively doing, we will see who He truly is. Have you been dependent on God? I challenge each of us to consider these attributes of God that can shape our lives as we try to grow in relationship with Him.

# WHAT MOVES YOU?

There are many things which can "move" a person emotionally, such as witnessing the birth of a child, a beautiful sunset or sunrise. I saw an image of Buffalo firefighters carrying a heart attack victim 10 blocks to Mercy Hospital in a foot of snow after the ambulance became stuck a blizzard.


How about a person who has not been able to hear since birth, and then, after receiving a cochlear implant where a small electronic device that electrically stimulates the cochlear nerve brings "new" life to the hearing impaired. Now, this person can hear birds singing and family members saying "I love you". This person can NOW hear words and sounds never known before. How about witnessing a child give a kiss to another schoolmate on the playground who has just fallen and skinned their knee?

I could go on and on with many similar stories that have the ability to move us emotionally, but, how about those things which move us "spiritually"? This past Sunday night Gabe led a closing hymn titled: The New Song. Although there were only about 100 in attendance, the singing was absolutely moving. What are some other things that can move us spiritually?

Does it move you when an erring child of God comes home? When a Brother or Sister in Christ walks down the aisle with tears in their eyes during the invitations song, are vou moved? Are vou moved when someone chooses rehabilitation instead of that next drink or that next "fix"? Are you moved when you read verses of Scripture like Romans 8:1 which tells Christians: "There is therefore now **no** condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. Does it move you to hear true stories from Scripture like the one about the woman who was caught in the very act of adultery? (John 8) By law, this woman should have been stoned to death, but Jesus said to the crowd who had stones in hand ready to kill her: "Let him who is without sin among you be the first to throw a stone at her." (John 8:7) Does this move you spiritually?

Does it move you when you read Scriptures like (I John 5:13-15) ""I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God that you may know that you have eternal life. And this is the confidence that we have toward Him, that if we ask anything according to h\His will He hears us. And if we know that He hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests that we have asked of Him"

This article began with a question, and I will end it the same: "What Moves You?
