1. A guide to public worship

2. Reminders of those in special need of prayer

The sick list, prayer list, those in the nursing home and other vital news about those in need of our help physically and spiritually are printed in the bulletin each week.

3. Activities/Ministries list

Special activities with the congregation and requests for help with church ministries are announced.

4. Reflective Bible Insight

Many articles are chosen to teach people How to Become a Christian or have great examples of how Christians need to be living. The bulletin often has ways to strengthen our faith. The bulletin is to be used as teaching material.

Much work goes in to producing a church bulletin each week. Please <u>take</u> the time and show an <u>interest in the church</u> by reading it each week. You might learn something.
