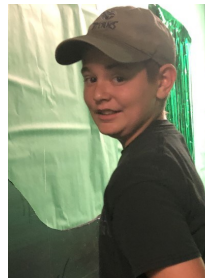
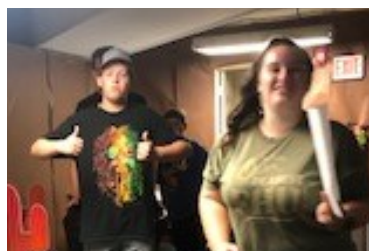

The book of Exodus is about God's redeeming love. Written by Moses (John 1:14), Exodus shows that God kept the promise He made to Abraham that He would give the patriarch's children the "Promised Land" (Gen. 15:13-14; Deut. 9:28).

Exodus is a continuation of the story of Genesis. God blesses the children of Abraham so that He can eventually bless every nation and family on the earth (Gen. 12:3; 22:18).

God had to redeem Israel out of Egyptian slavery. He performed ten plagues that judged stubborn Pharaoh. The last plague broke Pharaoh's will as God redeemed Israel with the blood of a lamb (Exod. 12:3-14).

The redemption God provided for His people foreshadowed a greater redemption by His own Son fifteen centuries later. Jesus was sacrificed like the Passover Lamb (John 1:29; 1 Cor. 5:7; 1 Pet. 1:18-20).

The Law that God provided from Sinai taught Israel how to live. The Law of Moses foreshadowed the Law that God's only Son would give.

Beginning this Sunday evening through Wednesday evening, we will examine important lessons from Exodus. A free community meal will be provided each week-night at 6 PM.

Teachers have already decorated their classrooms. There will be Bible lessons, skits, games, and refreshments.

Plan now to attend. Pray that God will use it for His eternal glory. Invite your neighbors especially their children. Bring your Bible and be prepared to have your life transformed by seeing the greatness of God.
