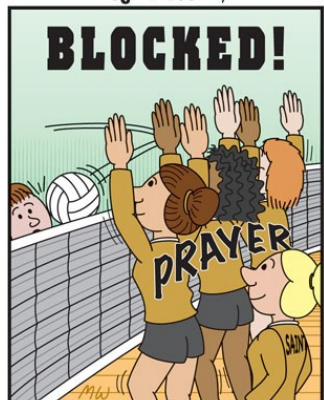

Every Father's Role Model

God created fathers to be an important part in the development of a child's character. When he is absent, children have a difficult time adjusting to life's adversities.

The US Census Bureau says that the United States is the world's leader in fatherless families with 18.5 million children growing up without a dad. 25% teens are without a father in the home. 70% of teens in rehab drug centers are without dads. 85% of teens with behavioral problems are without their dad. 90% of runaway/homeless teens are without a dad (<https://www.foxnews.com/opinion/america-crisis-fathers-17-June-2022>). This is absolutely scandalous and shows the corruption of families by Satan.

Because God has a special place in His heart for fatherless children, single mothers, grandparents, and guardians can teach the fatherless that God loves them. God is their Helper, Protector, and Father (Psa. 10:14; 68:5; 146:9). This means that God will retaliate against those who abuse fatherless children. God also commands His people to protect the fatherless (James 1:27).

What kind of father is God?

God the Father has pity on His children (Psa. 103:13). He knows when they are hurting physically, emotionally, financially, socially, and spiritually. He desires their well-being. A Good father likewise observes his children's joys and sorrows so they know that he cares.

God teaches, encourages, and disciplines His children so they can become mature (Heb. 12:5-10). Godly fathers instruct their children about the Creator. They do more than teach them how to make a living, they teach them how to live.

God is patient. He doesn't always punish His children for their mistakes. He gives them mercy and grace so they can learn from their errors and help others (2 Cor. 1:3-7). Ron Harper writes:

Fatherhood requires great patience. "Do not provoke your children to anger." There are times when inappropriate behavior can make us angry. When that happens, resist the urge to respond in such a way that promotes anger. Anger does not lead to thoughtful reflection. It very often leads to sin.

God protects His children who would do them harm (Deut. 1:31; Acts 13:18). Wise fathers know the vulnerabilities of their sons and daughters and guard them (1 Tim. 5:8).

God is the Father of all humans and angels (Heb. 12:9; Num. 16:22; Num. 27:16; Malachi 2:10). He is our role model in everything (1 Pet. 2:21).
