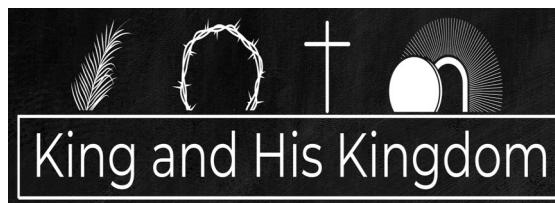

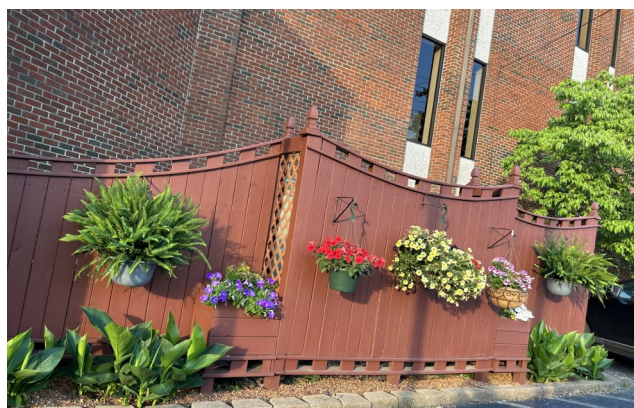
## Sympathy
