# **Summary of Camp Leatherwood 2023**

We thank God for a great week at Camp Leatherwood!! This was more than an opportunity to teach children how Jesus wants us to live, it was a time to demonstrate to them the Christ-like lifestyle.

Here are the numbers: 80 campers, 50 staff, 1 baptism (Teague Spencer, grandson of Jay & Marilyn Wilkins), about 20 hours of religious instruction, 14 meals for 130 people (1,820 total meals), close to ten hours of singing, about \$400 in cans redeemed for camp scholarships.

Theme for the week: <u>Moments on the Mountain</u>. All classes, devos, and skits centered around the theme.

Hundreds of man-hours were spent planning, cleaning, making phone calls & moving supplies. Our thanks to those who planned, recruited staff and workers, organized events, were counselors, served as nurse for injured and tired campers, cooked, washed dishes, did maintenance work to repair or replace broken equipment, hauled garbage off, stayed up all night to provide security, led singing, taught Bible classes, acted in skits, worked in Bible Hour with puppets, helped campers with arts and crafts, made sno-cones, served snacks from the canteen, served as lifeguards, took campers on hikes, or organized & refereed games.

Many campers were from our community and were not affiliated with any local congregation. We are grateful for those who contributed time and money to make the camp a success. Numerous staff scheduled a week's vacation to serve children. A person is never so tall in God's eyes until he stoops to help a child. When the church teaches children about Jesus, it is investing in its own future.

We Can Build up the Church by teaching children about Jesus. In this way we can build a church from the "ground floor" up. God has given us numerous opportunities for teaching including Sunday & Wednesday Bible schools, the church youth group, Bible camps, and Vacation Bible School. We show love to children when we show concern for their souls. Many in our community are "unchurched" and would consider attending a Bible class if invited.
