It seems to me that if you have a good doctor, he will already KNOW about the different medications out there and which one would work BEST for you.

Just as there are those who want to tell their doctor which medicine THEY would like to try, many are doing the same with another Doctor, The Great Physician, (Jesus). In Scripture Jesus is presented to us as "The Great Physician" and this is because He is able to wonders for the Body, Mind, Heart, and Soul.

Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John tell about countless folks whom Jesus healed of various illnesses and diseases. Every one of these folks followed Jesus' directions and let HIM be the Doctor.
