We have drug companies advertising all kinds of medicines for all kinds of ailments. It seems to me that if you have a good doctor, he will already KNOW about the different medications out there and which one would work BEST for you.

Just as there are those who want to tell their doctor which medicine THEY would like to try, many are doing the same with another Doctor, The Great Physician, (Jesus). In Scripture Jesus is presented to us as "The Great Physician" and this is because He is able to wonders for the Body, Mind, Heart, and Soul.

Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John tell about countless folks whom Jesus healed of various illnesses and diseases. Every one of these folks followed Jesus' directions and let HIM be the Doctor. Not one of those whom Jesus healed had to go back for a second treatment OR worry about side effects from *His* method of treatment.

Our Great Physician can do wonders for our minds. In Luke 8, Jesus encounters a man who was demon possessed and living in a cemetery. He was out of his mind and cut himself with stones. We as Christians have been given the gift of prayer. We are able to ask the Lord to bless us and heal both body and soul. He answers according to His will and on His timetable.
