## FIVE MINUTES WITH JESUS

What would you ask Jesus if you could sit down with Him for five minutes? What would you talk about? Whether they are Christians or not, most folks would like to ask Jesus a thing or two. I for one would love to have that kind of opportunity and believe it or not, it has been granted to us, but not in the way that you might think.

Christian friends are a gift from God and they are a wonderful blessing to our lives. Having been redeemed by the blood of Christ and "joined together" in His one body (Eph. 2:16-22) lets us know that our brothers and sisters in Christ should be our closest friends on this earth. All friendships require diligent effort on our part to keep them strong and healthy.

It's the same way with Jesus. While it's true that we will never sit down with the "physical" Jesus this side of heaven, we CAN sit down with the SAME Jesus, in (Spirit). We can read from Scripture, the very words of comfort and assurance that our Lord gave for all time. This will more than suffice until we see Jesus face to face. Consider this:

Jesus saw potential in His friends (John 1:36-51; Matt. 4:18-22).  
Jesus saw the best in them (Matt. 9:9).  
Jesus had compassion on His friends and provided for their needs (Matt. 9:36; 14:13-21; John 21:1-14).  
Jesus came down and stood on a level place with His friends (Luke 6:17).  
Jesus served His friends, even washing their feet (Matt. 20:28; John 13:1-17).  
Jesus comforted His friends in times of distress (Matt. 28:10; Lk 24:36; John 20:19-21).  
Jesus stuck with His friends through the storms of life (Matt. 8:23-27; 14:24-33).  
Jesus helped His friends, even in the middle of the night (Matt. 14:24-25).  
Jesus lent a hand to His friend, even when His friend was suffering the consequences of his own actions (Matt. 14:31).  
Jesus was troubled, groaned and wept at the grief and anguish of His friends (Jn 13:33-38).  
Jesus reassured His friends that with God all things are possible (Matt. 19:25-26).  
Jesus defended His friends against unwarranted criticism of their actions (John 12:1-8).  
Jesus defended His friends when they were charged with a serious offense (Matt. 12:1-8; 15:1-11).  
Jesus defended His friends against malicious slander, even when those friends were not around to defend themselves (Matt. 11:7-19).  
Jesus spoke highly and favorably of His friends, especially to their critics (Matt. 11:11).

A most beloved song that we sing from time to time in worship is titled: "What a Friend we Have in Jesus". The lyrics to this song tell us HOW to have the kind of interaction with Jesus that will sustain us, until such time that we are able to see Him face to face.

*What a friend we have in Jesus  
All our sins and griefs to bear  
And what a privilege to carry  
Everything to God in prayer  
Oh, what peace we often forfeit  
Oh, what needless pain we bear  
All because we do not carry  
Everything to God in prayer  
Have we trials and temptations?  
Is there trouble anywhere?  
We should never be discouraged  
Take it to the Lord in prayer  
Can we find a friend so faithful  
Who will all our sorrows share?  
Jesus knows our every weakness  
Take it to the Lord in prayer*

Jesus prayed for His friends, both in their presence (John 17) and out of their presence (Lk 6:12-13). Jesus loved His friends to the end (John 13:1), even giving His life for them, as completely undeserving as they were (John 15:13; 10:10).

**Having a friend IN Jesus, involves being a friend TO Jesus.**

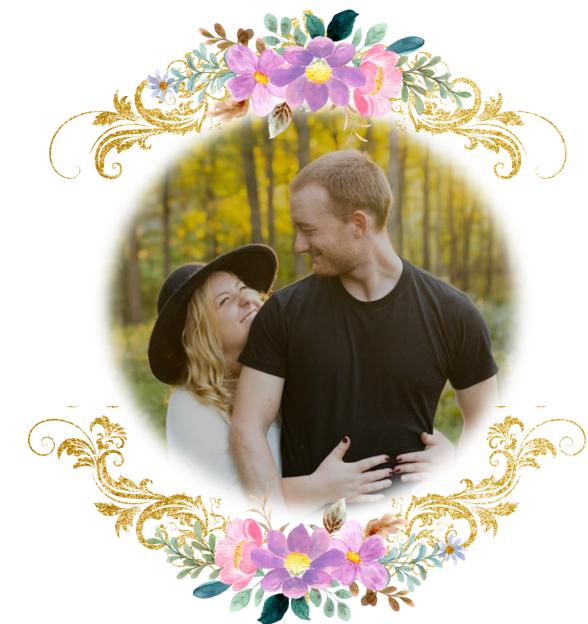
