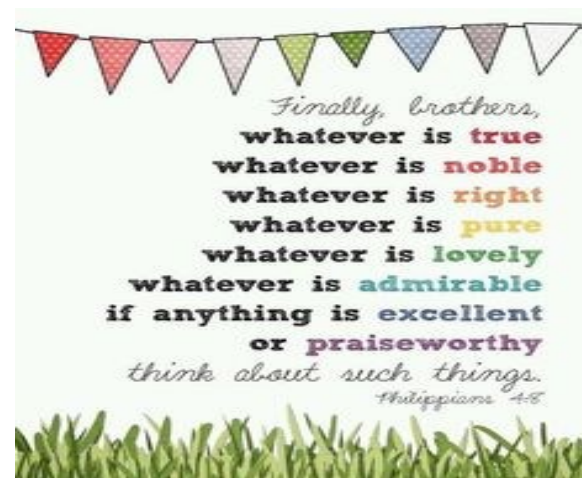
Wedding Shower
