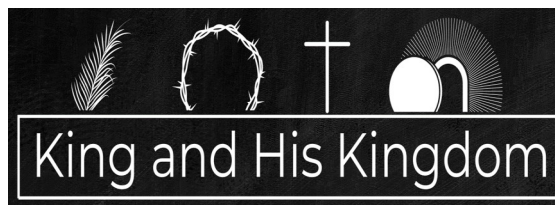

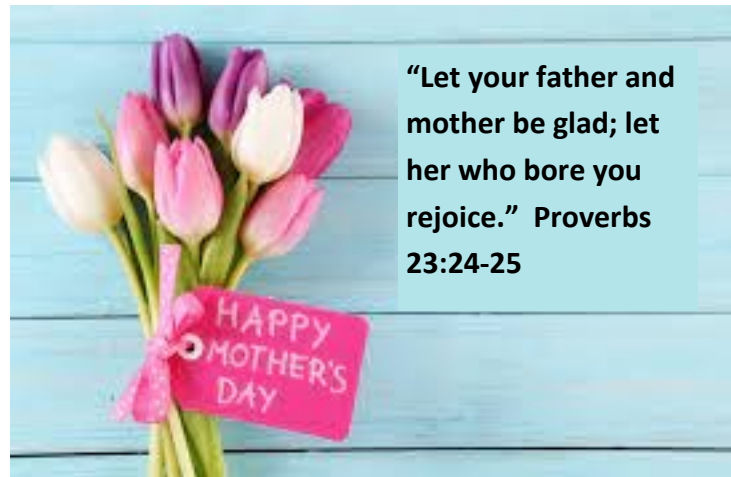

FROM THE COUCH

Mother's Day is this Sunday. "The hand that rocks the cradle rules the world." These words from William Ross Wallace (1818-1881) express a profound truth. They point to the importance of mothers and their impact on society. Abraham Lincoln once said, "All that I am or can be, I owe to my angel mother." The blessing of a loving, caring mother is one of God's great gifts to mankind. There is no single individual who can have more influence on a child than a Godly mother. A godly mother wants her children to go to Heaven. One great way to honor your mother is to be in worship this Sunday.

What do we do with our enemies? Jesus commanded us to love our enemies and pray for them (Matt. 5:43-48). Paul taught us to bless those who persecute us and not curse them. He also said for us to be ready to serve our enemies if they have needs. In doing so, we will make them ashamed of their opposition to us and we will overcome evil by doing good (Rom. 12:14-21). A saying that is sometimes attributed to Abraham Lincoln is, "I destroy my enemies by making them my friends." This was also taught in principle in the Law of Moses in Exod. 23:4-5 where the Jews were required to return their enemy's wayward livestock to them.

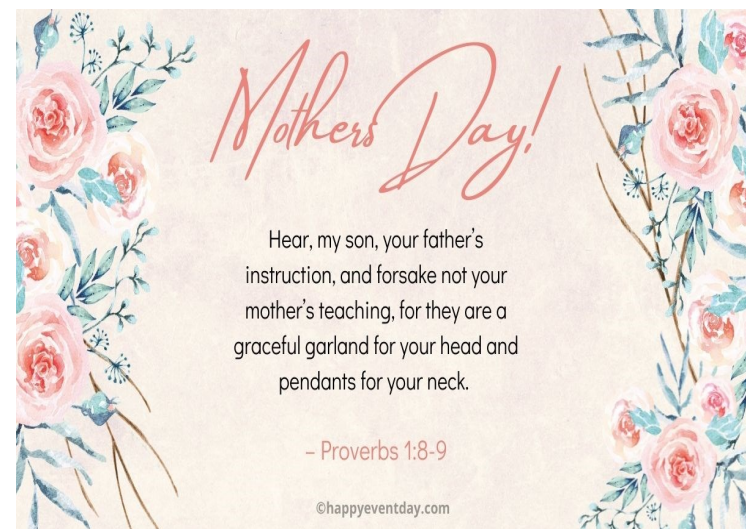

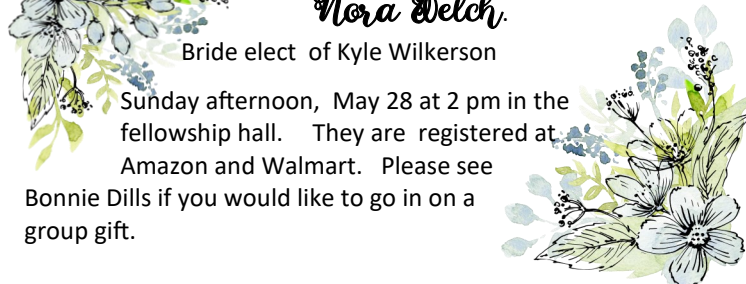
