The Crushing of the Serpent's Head

I recently saw the remains of a venomous snake whose head had been crushed by an automobile tire. It was a copperhead, Agkistrodon contortrix. Its body was still moving (by reflex), but it was dead.

I immediately thought of these 2 Bible passages:

Genesis 3:15 (ESV) "And I will put enmity between you & the woman & between your seed and her seed. He shall bruise your head and you shall bruise his heel."



Romans 16:20 (ESV) "And the God of Peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly."

In Genesis, God describes the conflict of good versus evil. He also describes the hostility that will occur between Jesus and Satan.

When the Lord was crucified, Satan figuratively bruised His heel. However when Christ was raised from the dead, Jesus crushed the serpent's head from which he has never recovered. He writhes in agony awaiting the final judgment when he will receive the eternal death penalty.

In Romans, Paul predicts that the forces of evil will soon be overthrown by the God of peace. The serpent (Satan, cp. Rev. 12:9) controlled the Roman government under Emperor Nero (AD 54-68). Although he seems to be invincible, his power is only temporary. He will murder many Christians including Peter and Paul. Eventually, the Roman Senate will tire of his antics and declare him an enemy of the state. In AD 68, Nero committed suicide.

In our own day it seems that Satan has complete of this world. But any advantage that evil seems to have over the forces of good is an illusion. It will only be temporary.

However, Jesus is still the King of kings (1 Tim. 6:15; Rev. 1:5; 17:14; 19:16). He will rule until He destroys death and then hands over His kingdom to the Father (1 Cor. 15:26-28).

On that Day, will He confess or deny your name before the Father (Matt. 10:32-33)?



- Elizabeth's son prepared people for the Lord (Luke 1:13-17)
- Mary watched her Son be crucified for the world's sin (John 19:26)


