It is a good custom that children remember their mothers on that special day called Mother's Day. What is the best gift they can give? A card or candy is always nice. Flowers of any kind or color are usually appreciated — even a flower from the yard or flower garden is very special if coming from a small child. But these gifts are not the greatest that you can give!

If your mother is a Christian, she has taught you to live as a Christian. She has been involved in teaching you about God and Christ, the Son of God (2 Timothy 1:5; 2 Timothy 3:14-15). Your mother has been interested in you learning about the church that Christ purchased with His own blood (Matthew 16:18; Acts 20:28). And when you became old enough, she was thrilled that you were born again by becoming a child of God (John 3:3-5). As you became old enough to leave home, she was naturally concerned about you. When you established your own home, she was proud and thankful that you had grown to maturity.

Now that it is Mother's Day, what can you give your mother? The greatest gift you could give to her is to be a faithful Christian. "I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth" (3 John 4). In the context John was talking about his spiritual children, but it is also true that Christian mothers can have no greater gift than to know that their own children are living faithfully as children of God. If you and your mother live faithfully, then someday you can both live with God eternally in heaven.
