What It Means to Be 'In Christ'

"..for in Christ Jesus I begat you through the gospel"

(1 Corinthians 4:15).

Paul mentions repeatedly the phrase "in Christ" in connection with some phase of our relationship with God. He says we are baptized into Christ (Gal. 3:27; Rom. 6:3); that the Spirit of Christ dwells in us (Rom. 8:9) and that we are made nigh (accepted with) by the blood of Christ (Eph. 2:13). But, what are the advantages of being "in Christ"? The following are

- 1. We are children of God. Gal. 3:26 states we are children of God in Christ Jesus, through faith. We cannot be God's children outside of Christ, and Paul says we are baptized into
- 2. All spiritual blessings are in Christ. Ephesians 1:3 so states. All men enjoy God's physical blessings: rain, sunshine, crops, etc., but spiritual blessings: salvation, prayer providence, etc., are in Christ.
- 3. We are new creatures in Christ. Second Cor. 5:17 assures us that in Christ, old things slavery to sin, condemnation, Satan's power are all ineffective. All things are now new: new life, new values, new goals, new relationship with God.

What does it mean to be "in Christ"?

It means everything!

6 REMINDERS FROM ALL 6 CHAPTERS OF GALATIANS

- 1. Don't live for the approval of others - Galatians 1:10
- 2. You are not defined by your past -Galatians 2:20
- 3. Your worth is in Christ, not your job or education - Galatians 3:27
- 4. You are no longer a slave, you are now a child of God - Galatians 4:7
- 5. Don't be led by feelings and emotions, be led by the spirit - Galatians 5:25
- 6. Don't grow weary while doing good. When the time is right, you will reap what you've sown - Galatians 6:9
