What It Means to Be ‘In Christ’

“..for in Christ Jesus I begat you through the gospel”
(1 Corinthians 4:15).

Paul mentions repeatedly the phrase “in Christ” in connection with some phase of our relationship with God. He says we are baptized into Christ (Gal. 3:27; Rom. 6:3); that the Spirit of Christ dwells in us (Rom. 8:9) and that we are made nigh (accepted with) by the blood of Christ (Eph. 2:13). But, what are the advantages of being “in Christ”? The following are only three:

1. **We are children of God.** Gal. 3:26 states we are children of God in Christ Jesus, through faith. We cannot be God’s children outside of Christ, and Paul says we are baptized into Christ.

2. **All spiritual blessings are in Christ.** Ephesians 1:3 so states. All men enjoy God’s physical blessings: rain, sun- shine, crops, etc., but spiritual blessings: salvation, prayer providence, etc., are in Christ.

3. **We are new creatures in Christ.** Second Cor. 5:17 as- sures us that in Christ, old things slavery to sin, condemna- tion, Satan’s power are all ineffective. All things are now new: new life, new values, new goals, new relationship with God.

What does it mean to be “in Christ”?
It means everything!
