

Words from Ethan...



Mental health professionals say that gratitude is the healthiest attitude men can cultivate. They also add that vengeance is the most destruc-

In its 300 years of existence, Yale University's most popular course is on how to be happy. More than 3.5 million people have taken the free, online

course. One of the course requirements is to keep a "gratitude journal," where students document what others have done for them and how they are thankful (https://www.cnn.com/2022/01/23/us/yalehappiness-course-pandemic-wellness/index.html, published 23 Jan. 2022, retrieved 15 Nov. 2022). The apostle Paul documents the spiritual decline of the Gentiles into godless unbelief. Even though they knew God, they refused to worship or



express gratitude to Him (Romans 1:21). Their ingratitude had a devastating impact on their character development as it spiraled into degeneracy
