They Just Don't Get It.

Have you ever watched someone trying to figure out a problem, when the *answer* to their dilemma was right in front of them? It makes me think of a person who has been frantically looking for their glasses, only to realize that they were on top of their head the whole time. It was right in front of them, but they just didn't "get it".

Until the worldly person realizes that there IS a God and that He *demands* obedience to His will, *they* will never "get" it. In fact, they will be forever lost. Many exclaim: "God needs to make it clear that He even exists!" The worldly person wants *proof* that God exists, and they don't want US to use the BIBLE to do so. Is this a tall order? Not at all.

The Bible even *says* that God can be proved "outside" the Bible. Romans 1:20 tells us: "For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse,"

When one observes the universe with all its wonders, like how the earth works in perfect harmony with the rest of the universe, one can't help but KNOW that a higher power must exist. This is where the rubber meets the road. If a person is genuinely looking for God, he or she WILL find Him according to (Matthew 7:7)

Even the Godless person has noticed that over the past 50 years American Society is less respectful, less serious, and less self-controlled. More and more people are flippant and irreverent when it comes to "religion". Claiming to be wise, they became fools."


