From the Couch

Homecoming & Family Day This Sunday. Steve Kirby of the Hilldale Church in Clarksville will be with us this Sunday, Oct. 24 and will be speaking on the topic, "What is the Christian's purpose?" Bible class begins at 9 AM with worship at 10 AM and 1 PM. At 11 AM, we plan to have a meal together. Pray for a successful day but be sure also to invite others to be with us.

White Bluff Fall Festival. Thanks to all who helped with our booth at the city's Fall Festival. We distributed about 36 Bibles, talked to dozens of people who stopped by to say hello, & encouraged people to read their Bibles. We also gave away cold waters & many cups of hot chocolate.

Our Schools of Preaching. Our brotherhood has been blessed by a number of schools of preaching worldwide and they are doing a great work in equipping the next generation of preachers to do God's work. The Nashville School of Preaching has about 90 people enrolled in classes for the fall quarter. About 50 of them take classes by Zoom. Since 2010, more than 100 graduates of NSOP have been placed in some pulpit.

God willing, the last week of October & the first week of November, I will teach a twelve hour course by Zoom on the book of Psalms for the Somerset School of Preaching in Cape Town, South Africa. Students from several countries in Africa come to Cape Town to attend the school. The school, is partly supported by the Crieve Hall church in Nashville.

Gospel Preacher to Debate Well-Known Atheist. On Wednesday, October 25, 2023, from 10:30 AM to 12:30 PM, Brother Kyle Butt is scheduled to debate one of the most heralded atheists in the world, Dr. Michael Shermer, on the specific proposition, "The God of the Bible Exists." Shermer became a Presbyterian as a teenager but renounced God after his college girlfriend was paralyzed in an automobile accident. For 18 years, Shermer wrote a monthly column for Scientific American. The debate will take place on the campus of Faulkner University in Montgomery, AL and can be viewed live at: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=90PQQM4a75w.

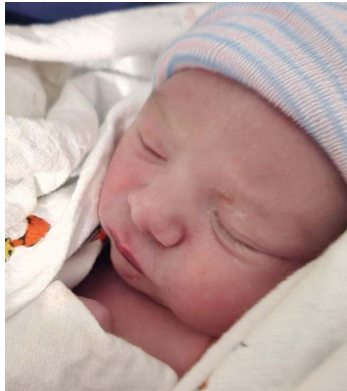


Welcome New Baby

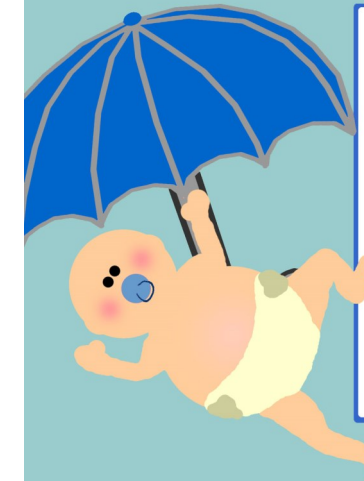
