Galatians 5:22-23



We discussed the difference between happiness and joy. We identified happiness as a feeling that is determined on our surroundings and season of life. We then identified joy as a feeling of being content in life no matter a high or low season in life. Joy remains constant.

"You make known to me the path of life; **in your presence there is fullness of joy**; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore." — Psalm 16:11

I encourage you to take the time with your teen and read all of Psalm 16. It is short, but extremely powerful seeing the comfort David found in Christ.

The empty tomb is what made the difference between our happiness lasting a little while and our joy that can be found in Christ forever.
