NOTE TAKERS...

- I've titled today's message: “Family Warning.”
  - READ (1 John 2:18-27) NKJV.

~ INTRO ~

LAST WEEK... WE TURNED A CORNER...

- As we studied (vv.12-17)...
  - By seeing how John was addressing the Churches.

THE TAKE AWAY BOILED DOWN TO TWO THINGS:

1) ***The Family Make Up*** (vv.12-14)

- Fathers – mature believers.
- Young men – growing believers.
- Children – new believers.

AND WE BROKE IT DOWN...

- Into some basic understanding like this:
  - i. The IMMATURE BELIEVER (*little children*)...
    - Is new to the faith and trying to figure out what's *right & wrong*.
      - Intoxication / sex / & entertainment.
  - ii. The GROWING BELIEVER (*young men*)...
    - Has experienced some freedom & victory over sin...
      - And the questions being asked turn to... *is this good or bad*.
        - All things are lawful, but not all things are profitable.
  - iii. The MATURE BELIEVER (*fathers*)...
    - Asks... *“Is this the will of God for my life?”*

2) ***Family Direction*** (vv.15-17)

- i. *Lust of the flesh* = ***Contradicts faith in God.***
- ii. *Lust of the eyes* = ***Leads away from faith in God.***
- iii. *Pride of life* = ***Twists faith in God.***

(1 John 2:18-27)  
“Family Warning”

(1<sup>st</sup> John) WAS WRITTEN...

- As a book of practical proofs to see if a person is in the faith.

JOHN SAID... MANY CLAIM TO BE FOLLOWERS OF CHRIST...

- But they don't obey Christ.
  - AND John tells us they are liars AND the truth is not in them!

~STUDY~

HERE'S A FEW THINGS WE CAN LEARN TODAY:

BIG IDEA – RECOGNIZE THE TIME: (vv.18-19)

OK...

- John circles back to the “*little children*” (v.13)...
  - Those who are NEW to the faith.

AND HE SETS THE URGENCY OF THE HOUR...

- With two critical lessons for the church: (v.18)

1) **Statement...** “*It is the last hour*”

THIS PHRASE...

- Does NOT describe a *duration of time*...
  - But a *kind of time* <sup>1</sup>

LET ME GIVE YOU AN EXAMPLE...

- (Rev. 1:1) NKJV
  - “*Shortly*”... The idea is NOT soon, BUT suddenly.

OK... THE SECOND THING JOHN SAYS IN (v.18)...

2) Signs of ... “*the last hour*”

**Antichrist** = (Singular) A specific title of the man from (Rev. 13:1)... who is the beast rising out of the sea with both political & economic power.

(Rev. 13:1-2) NKJV says...

(1 John 2:18-27)  
“Family Warning”

- (v.1) Where he comes from = Gentile nations.
- (v.2a) Traits he possesses = Resembles kings from the past.
  - (Greece / Medo-Persian / Babylon)
- (v.2b) The power he has = Comes from Satan.
  - c.p. (Matt. 4:8-9) NKJV

NEXT WE HAVE...

**antichrists** = (plural) This is NOT the sinister character in Revelation. Rather this describes many people who are defiant toward authority; rebellious;

- AND breach or abandon the Christian faith.

THIS TYPE OF PERSON...

- Is also referred to as an apostate = From the Greek word *apostasia*

IT'S A TECHNICAL WORD...

- From the 1<sup>st</sup> century... that described political revolts. <sup>2</sup>

AND... IN THE CHURCH...

- An apostate is revealed in two main forms:
  - a) They **fall away from the doctrines** of the historical church.

THE SECOND TRAIT OF AN apostate

- b) **Renounce** the Christian faith & **abandon** Christ's body.

(v.19) NLT

Observation – there are many people who get sifted off...

- OR pruned away from churches.

AND... we should come to maturity BY understanding...

- It's a health body that can purge the poison from itself.

SO TOO... AT DIFFERENT TIMES...

“Family Warning”

- This fellowship... sees people come and go.
  - And I want to remind you...
    - To use the lens of scripture to understand turn-over.

BECAUSE WHEN DOCTRINE IS DISCARDED...

- OR relationships are broken off in unbiblical ways...
  - You can be sure there's an UNGODLY PERSON...
    - (An apostate) in your midst.

HERE'S THE POINT... DON'T MISS IT...

- John doesn't want the church to be deceived!

READ (v.22) Who is a liar?

- From the beginning of this epistle...
  - John has been using this word **liar** frequently.

(1 John 2:4) NLT

*“If someone claims, ‘I know God,’ but doesn’t obey God’s commandments, that person is a liar and is not living in the truth.”*

REMEMBER...

- There are relational standards...
  - God has placed within His word.

AND A FOLLOWER OF JESUS...

- Will not live in an ongoing pattern of opposition...
  - To what God has said!
    - Unless... they're a “Liar”
      - a) One who breaks faith.
      - b) One who does not have faith.

READ (vv.26-27)

IF CHRIST IS ALIVE IN YOU...

- Then you'll want to be filled with His ways!

I WANT TO DISTRIBUTE...

(1 John 2:18-27)  
“Family Warning”

- The grace of God over your life in three ways:

#1) IF YOU WANT TO BECOME...

- Part of the family of God you have to acknowledge Jesus in your life.
  - By submitting to His ways.

*[Jesus] I Am the way the truth and the life  
and no man comes to the Father except thru me.*

#2) PERHAPS...

- You're a person who has abused the family...
  - And you need to make amends today.

#3) MAYBE YOU'RE A PERSON LIKE JONAH...

- You're NOT denying your affiliation with God...
  - You're denying your assignment from God.
