### NOTE TAKERS...

- I've titled this message: <u>"Understanding My Calling"</u>

➤ (Exodus 3:1-22) NKJV

### ~ *INTRO* ~

### OK... IN (Exodus)...

- We learn how God's redemption story...
  - Moves out of (Genesis) and into the next phase.
- We learned that 70-people (Israel)...
  - ➤ Turned into 2-million people +/-

### AND TODAY...

- We see that God had prepared a man Moses for 40-years...
  - ➤ And the Lord commissions him in this chapter.

### CAN I ENCOURAGE YOU WITH THIS!?!

- No matter how long you have walked with the Lord...
  - ➤ Please understand... God still has work for you to do.

### HERE'S A FEW THINGS WE CAN LEARN:

## <u>IDEA #1 – HEARING GOD'S VOICE:</u> (vv.1-5)

### I LOVE THIS ABOUT GOD!

- No one is <u>too old</u> OR <u>too young</u> to be used by God.
  - ➤ The question is will I walk by faith!?!

### NOW...

- You may struggle to recognize God's voice at first.
  - ➤ But that's not problem!
    - O You're not the first one.

## **EXAMPLE:**

(1 Sam. 3:4-10) NKJV

- ➤ (v.4) At 12-yrs old God called to Samuel at an unexpected time.
- > (v.6) God called a second time.
- $\triangleright$  (v.8) The Lord called a third time.
- $\triangleright$  (v.10) The fourth time Samuel knew how to answer.

### HERE'S THE POINT....

- Learning to hear God's voice take practice.
  - ➤ It's just like a baby learning it's parents voice.

### (James 1:6) NKJV

SO...

- What type of response should I have...
  - ➤ When I hear the voice of God?

### LET'S LEARN FROM THE BIBLE.

- Isaiah the prophet heard God's voice after his sin was forgiven...
  - And this was his response (Isa. 6:8) NKJV
    - o "Here I am! Send me."

## **THREE BASIC CALLS IN THE CHRISTIAN LIFE:**

- 1) Salvation (John 3:16-17) NKJV
  - ➤ Offered to anyone who would accept it.
- 2) Sanctification (set apart) (Acts 26:18) NKJV
  - > To be sanctified means God's Word has had an effect on you.
- 3) Service (Rom. 12:1) NKJV
  - ➤ A life of service is the right response to the grace you received.

MOSES – responded to God

 $SAMUEL-responded\ to\ God$ 

ISAIAH – responded to God

PAUL – responded to God

AND YOU'RE TO RESPOND TO GOD!

## <u>IDEA #2 – LEARNING GOD'S HEART:</u> (vv.6-10)

- (v.6) I am the God of your fathers
- (v.7) I have seen the oppression of my people / I know their sorrows
- (v.8) I have come to deliver them
- (v.9) I hear their cry

### GOD'S HEART IS FOR HIS PEOPLE...

- So... He selects and a sends a human instrument to help.

### BUT MOSES (v.11)...

- Started doubting and making excuses as to why he was not the guy!

## IN (Ps. 32:8-9) NKJV...

- King David wrote...
  - God will <u>instruct</u> us and <u>teach</u> us in the way we should go.

### I DON'T BLAME MOSES FOR HIS INITIAL RESPONSE!

- I had the same dreadful fear before planting this church.
  - ➤ Back in (April 2011) God made (Ps. 32:8-9) personal...
    - o To instruct my mind & lead my heart.
      - And to keep me back from running away.

### BUT...

- This does NOT mean there will be an absence of fear!
  - Rather... we learn that **FAITH** triumphs over fear...
    - o As I trust in the living God.

### TONIGHT...

- Maybe this is what you need... to tack action with...
  - ➤ Problems in your marriage
  - > Selecting a spouse
  - ➤ Choosing a school
  - > Finding a new job / career
  - ➤ Parenting your kids
  - > Serving in the church
  - ➤ Dealing with extend family
  - > Getting over depression

> Or moving beyond addiction

### WHATEVER THE SITUATION...

- God tells us...
  - ➤ (Jer. 33:3) NKJV
  - > (Ps. 119:18) NKJV

## <u>IDEA #3 – DOING GOD'S WILL:</u> (vv.11-22)

### CAN WE RECOGNIZE...

- That God does NOT reject *honest questions* (v.13).
  - ➤ He wants us to speak freely.
- But He also does NOT accept <u>lame excuses</u> (v.11).

### THE OBJECTIVE OF THE CHURCH...

- Is to make disciples & appoint leaders.
  - ➤ Not perfect people...
    - But people making progress.

### PAUL SAID IT THIS WAY...

- (2 Tim. 2:1-2) NKJV
