 - The Bible is made up of 66-books.
 - It was written by 40 different authors.
 - It was written over a period of 1,500-years.
 - And in 3-languages.

POINT BEING...

- God has given mankind a central message about life...

➤ (Both our origin & purpose).
○ God has given man: Basic Instruction Before Leaving Earth.

NOW... The **Old Testament**...

- Is made up of 39-books / 929 chapters / with 23,214 verses.
 - Which... narrate the story from *Creation*...
 - Until the *First Advent of Christ*.

NEXT... The **New Testament**...

- Is made up of 27-books / 260 chapters / with 7,959 verses.

IN TOTAL...

- The Bible is 66-books / 1,189 chapters / with 31,173 verses.

HERE'S THE COOL THING...

- If we break this down into daily increments...
 - You can read thru the entire Bible in 1-year...
 - By reading it for 12-minutes a day.

NOW... THE SWINDOLL STUDY BIBLE²

- Notes that the first five-books of the Old Testament...
 - **(Gen. thru Deut.)** were written by Moses.
- AND these books chronicle a series of foundational events.

FOR EXAMPLE:

- 1) God creating of the world.
- 2) God selecting & using a man – Abraham the Father of Faith.
- 3) God's promise & growth of Abrahams family into a Nation – **Israel**.
- 4) God's deliverance of **Israel** out of slavery from the Egyptians.
- 5) God's law given to **Israel** – How To's for living in relationship with God.
- 6) God's care for **Israel** in the wilderness.
- 7) God bringing **Israel** to the edge of the *Promised Land*.

THAT'S A HIGH-LEVEL SUMMARY...

- Of the **first five books** of the Bible.

NOW... MOSES' AUTHORSHIP...

- Is confirmed by Jesus in [\(John 5:45-47\) NKJV](#).
 - Yet, we should understand that Moses didn't come on the scene...
 - Until about 400-years after the events of [\(Genesis\)](#).

HERE'S WHAT'S INTERESTING.

- Moses is coming into the God given promises of [\(Genesis\)](#)...
 - And then in the remaining four books he writes...
 - They record **Israel's** responses to those promises...
 - (Literally... his generation's response to God!)

AT TIMES HIS PEOPLE...

- Lived they seemed to exercise faith...
 - BUT... their lives were characterized by rebellion & unbelief.

THESE ARE...

- Real people who wrestled with faith in God.
 - “Can God be trusted to care for me!?!?”

FINALLY...

- Next week as we open our Bibles and move into [\(Genesis\)](#)...
 - Understand... that there's 2,000 years of history covered...
 - Between [\(Gen. 1 – 11\)](#).

AND... IF WE BREAK THEM DOWN...

- Here's what we get:

- I. [Creation \(Gen. 1-2\)](#)
- II. [Fall of man into sin \(Gen. 3\)](#)
- III. [Earth being populated & the effects of sin spread \(Gen. 4-5\)](#)
- IV. [God floods & destroys the earth \(Gen. 6 - 8\)](#)
- V. [Noah's Family / Human Government / Dispersion at Babel \(Gen. 9-11\).](#)

LET ME INTRODUCE YOU TO A **TERM**.

- The Bible is organized into what is called – *dispensations*.

Got Questions.org says...

*In theology, a dispensation is the divine administration of a period of time; each dispensation is... [an] appointed age. Dispensationalism is a theological system that recognizes these ages ordained by God to order the affairs of the world.*³

There Are Seven Dispensations⁴

From Genesis to Revelation:

- 1) Innocence ([Genesis 1:1—3:7](#)).
- 2) Conscience ([Genesis 3:8—8:22](#)).
- 3) Human Government ([Genesis 9:1—11:32](#)).
- 4) Promise ([Genesis 12:1—Exodus 19:25](#)).
- 5) Law ([Exodus 20:1—Acts 2:4](#)).
- 6) Grace ([Acts 2:4—Revelation 20:3](#)).
 - The church is birthed here... & Christ returns to rule the earth.
- 7) The Millennial Kingdom ([Revelation 20:4—6](#)).

SO... UNDERSTAND...

- That the *dispensations*... segment world history...
 - And show us how God relates to humanity...
 - Within the given *dispensation*.
