NOW... AS WE CONTINUE...

- Our study in (Proverbs 2)...
 - We're discussing the value of wisdom.

PRACTICAL THINGS...

- To help us navigate beyond the landmines of life.

NOW...

- *Proverbs...* were common in the ancient world.
 - ➤ They were the conduit...
 - o For the sharing practical truths.

FOR US IN 2025...

- We're inclined to dive into a Google search OR ChatGPT.
 - ➤ Which are completely fine!

HOWEVER...

- Biblical PROVERBS... provide moral direction for the **soul**
 - The animation & value of all human life as God sees it.
 - So these *Proverbs* are perspectives inspired by God.

BLOCK #1 – THE PURSUIT OF WISDOM: (vv.1-5)

SOME PEOPLE...

- Don't grow as Christian's...
 - ➤ Simply because They don't apply themselves.

These verses define the <u>pursuit</u> of wisdom...

- And the <u>result</u> of that pursuit.
- (v.1) *Receive / treasure* = <u>Investment</u>... valuing what God has to say.
 - Living by His word is an <u>investment</u> for now & eternity.
 - With benefits in the present as well as the future.
- (v.2) *Incline* (to prick the ear... like an animal detecting a sound).
 - *Apply* = actions / attitudes / beliefs... which a person willingly receives.

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➤ (This is the opposite of doubt).

- (v.3) = Prayer...
 - Asking God for insight into His ways (knowledge).
- (v.4) = Bible study...
 - <u>It's like exercise</u>... (the more you do it the better you get).
 - > The more you study the Bible...
 - o The better you get at understanding God.

RESULT... (v.5)

BLOCK #2 – THE BENEFITS OF WISDOM: (vv.6-8)

LET'S START WITH KNOWING GOD'S HEART.

- God's desires to give His children the Kingdom...
 - > (Luke 12:31-32) NKJV
- The "kingdom of God" is not just a place—it's God's active rule...
 - Over our lives.

THERE ARE TANGIBLE DAILY BENEFITS...

- In following God (Ps. 103:2-5) NKJV.
- (v.6) = Wisdom... this Hebrew word covers a **spectrum** of ideas.
 - But consider this (James 1:5) NKJV
 - He also gives *knowledge* = Perception & skill
 - ➤ *Understanding* = Intelligence & insight
 - (The believer often cry's out God help me!)
- (v.7) = Sound wisdom (lasting success)...
 - (2 Chronicles 1:10) NKJV
- (v.8) =Prolonged days (1 Kings 3:14) NKJV.
 - Personal protection (2 Sam. 22:31) NKJV.

BLOCK #3 – THE TRANSFORMATION OF WISDOM: (vv.9-11)

YOU WILL SEE THINGS DIFFERENTLY...

- As your mind is saturated with God's perspective!

➤ (Rom. 12:2) NKJV

TWO POINTS...

- As we grow in the grace and knowledge of God...
 - ➤ Our perspectives are changed we're transformed.
 - o The end result is
 - (v.10) "knowledge will fill you with joy."

(v.11) "Discretion will preserve you."

- The idea is learning to separate that which is good...
 - From that which is harmful.

BLOCK #4 – THE PROTECTION OF WISDOM: (vv.12-19)

(1 Cor. 15:33) NKJV

"Do not be deceived: Evil company corrupts good habits."

TWO IDEAS...

- (v.12) *Protection from bad company*
- (vv.13-15) Protection from bad practices

THE NEW TESTAMENT...

- Gives categories of sin that shipwrecks Christians *Bad Practices*.
 - ➤ (Gal. 5:19-21) NKJV

1. Sexual sins

- a) Adultery
- b) Fornication
- c) Lewdness

2. Superstitious sins

a) *Idolatry*

*An *idol* is anything we look to as a source of:

- 1) Identity
- 2) Security
- 3) Meaning for life other than God
- b) Sorcery / witchcraft

3. Violent sins

- a) Hatred
- b) Contentions
- c) Jealousy
- d) Outburst

4. Manipulative sins

- a) Selfish ambitions
- b) Dissensions
- c) Heresies
- d) Envy

5. Social sins

- a) Drunkenness
- b) Revelries / orgies

AGAIN...

- The point of this Proverb is to <u>deliver from</u> harmful practices.

(vv.16-19)

NOW...

- When someone slides away from God its always progressive.
 - ➤ These verses provide wisdom & give a path of protection:
 - a) Protection from bad company (v.12)
 - b) Protection from bad practices (vv.13-15)
 - c) Protection from bad desires (vv.16-19)

WHY?

BECAUSE...

- Following this lifestyle results in spiritual & physical death (v.19)

FINALLY...

BLOCK #5 – THE END RESULT OF WISDOM: (vv.20-22)

GOD SHOWS US...

- The end result of wisdom at the beginning.
 - ➤ So we can avoid taking the wrong road.
