THE LAST TIME WE WERE TOGETHER...

- We read the historical way God chose certain men...
 - AND... then we studied thru four topics of *election*:
 - o Election begins with God's choice
 - o Election shows God's character
 - o Election shows God's mercy
 - o Election shows God's <u>fairness</u>

~ *STUDY* ~

TODAY...

- We look at (Rom.10) and the *justice of God*.

<u>IDEA #1 – KNOW WHAT YOU BELIEVE</u> (vv.1-13)

(v.2) ZEAL = A great energy in pursuit of a cause or objective.

TODAY THE WORLD IS FILLED WITH...

- All sorts of <u>religions</u> trying to earn God's approval...
 - > By being a good person.
 - o Only to miss the way God accepts.

IN THE CHURCH...

- Men & women alike want to serve God...
 - ➤ But they reject Jesus & His way.

(John 14:6) "*I Am the way*..."

(John 14:15) "If you love Me, keep My commandments."

SERVING GOD...

- Starts with knowing God.
 - AND <u>zeal</u> must be combined with <u>truth</u>.

(v.3) PAUL GIVES THE ERROR OF THE JEWS & OTHERS.

- People want to bypass the baby the Christ.
 - > By refusing to submit to the Son of God...

- Who fulfilled the law...
 - And paid the price for all human sin.

NOW... PAUL TAKES FROM (Deut. 30:11-17)

- When Moses was talking about <u>living a life of faith</u>.

SO TOO...

- Paul is explaining how a life of faith starts...
 - > Thru the doctrines of <u>incarnation</u> & <u>resurrection</u>
 - o Which are to be followed by faith.
- (v.6) He's speaking about the incarnation of Christ...
 - (John 1:1 & 14) NKJV
 - ➤ God incarnate 100% God & 100% man.
 - o In theology it's called the *Hypostatic union*.
- (v.7) Advances to the resurrection of Christ.
- (v.8) This is the Gospel message of Christ... (the forgiveness of sins)
 - Which can only be received by *faith* in what Jesus did...
 - And NOT by works of merit.
 - o He saying this is NOT too hard to understand.
- (v.9a) Now he explains how to respond in faith:

Confess = The idea is to vocalize a pledge.

<u>CONFESSION</u>...

- Is NOT empty talk in an emotional moment...
 - Rather it's a bold... public proclamation...
 - Of one's conviction and hope in Christ.

THE PERSON THE JEW'S REJECTED...

- Was the baby from Bethlehem...
 - > The <u>incarnation</u> of God.
- Jesus in the NT is the Lord (Jehovah) in the OT.
 - > (John 1:14) NKJV

 $\underline{Lord} = (G#2962) ku-re-os...$

- One who has control of another.
- Ruler of one's life.
- To whom a person or thing belongs.

(v.9b) Belief in the resurrection...

(vv.10-13)

HERE'S THE POINT...

This is what saving faith looks like:

- 1) The **mind** as it understands the Gospel message.
- 2) The **emotions** expressing sorrow over sin & joy over grace.
- 3) And deals with the submission of <u>will</u> to Christ for control.

MANY...

- Feed into the cultural-Christian delusion...
 - Filled with all grace & NO truth.
 - o People "Want Jesus to be savior, BUT not Lord"
- They want fire insurance from Hell...
 - Without repentance and surrender to Christ.

THAT'S NOT THE GOSPEL MESSAGE!

- The cultural-Christian needs to be saved...
 - > Because they have bought the lie of Satan.
 - o That prostitutes God's grace...
 - While keeping SELF on the throne.

GANG...

- Jesus is Lord over all OR He's not Lord at all.

THIS IS WHAT (v.13) POINTS TO...

- Which is quoted from (Joel 2:32).

POINT BEING...

- All people are saved the same way – by embracing Christ Jesus.

IDEA #2 – Responsibility & Response (vv.14-21)

FIRST...

- We need to own the fact...
 - ➤ That Jesus saves **FROM** something YES.
 - O But He also saves **FOR** something.

I THINK PASTORS...

- Get this wrong when WE don't teach the whole Bible.

LET ME EXPLAIN...

- The final verses and then provide an application.

IN THE FINAL VERSES...

- Paul quotes the OT (x6)

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(v.15) = (Isa. 52:7)
(v.16) = (Isa. 53:1)
(v.18) = (Ps. 19:4)
(v.19) = (Deut. 32:21-b)
(v.20) = (Isa. 65:1)
(v.21) = (Isa. 65:2)
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~ IN CLOSING ~

THE TAKEAWAY FROM ALL OF THIS.

- Israel chose not to listen & they were not ready when Jesus came...
 - > They turned a deaf ear & a blind eye to the scriptures...
 - o Their hearts grew hard when confronted...
 - With what God wanted.

BUT Paul was hoping they would have a "Breakthrough"

AND BY WAY OF APPLICATION...

- The ones who are saved take the gospel forward.
 - > They support the mission financially
 - > They engage in serving faithfully
 - ➤ They receive the word with eagerness
 - ➤ They live a life of love for God & others
