THE BIG IDEA...

- In these verses is: *Living like a Christian*.

CHRISTIANITY IS A WAY OF LIVING...

- **Not** just a way of believing.
 - > Our beliefs are tied to actions, which are lived out (faith).

LAST TIME...

- We discovered how to *live like a Christians*...
 - > Toward people INSIDE the family of faith.

TODAY...

- We discover how to *live like a Christians*...
 - Toward people OUTSIDE the family of faith.

REMEMBER...

- Paul's teaching the church.
 - > It's not that we have all this stuff down.
 - We're learning how to live as Christians.

<u>IDEA #1 – OVERCOMING OPPOSITION:</u> (v.17)

LIVING LIKE A CHRISTIAN...

- Toward those outside the family of faith...
 - ➤ Must be lived intentionally.

(Proverbs 3:3-4) NLT

- (v.3) *loyalty & kindness* are qualities God wants us to live out.

SIDE NOTE:

Dr. Albert Mohler...

- "In a Post-Christian society...
 - ➤ <u>Kindness</u> is the first social-grace to disappear."
- Crude, vulgar, & unpleasantness spreads thru public interactions...
 - ➤ When the Christian ethic is abandoned.

POINT BEING:

- Our Christian influence makes a tangible difference.
- Don't discount God's power in kindness.

(Proverbs 3:4) Two benefits:

- 1) Favor
- 2) A good reputation

(Proverbs 22:1) NLT

(v.17b) – HERE'S THE INSTRUCTION:

- Let people **SEE** our good works and they will glorify God.
 - 1) (Matt. 5:16) NKJV Jesus said...
 - o The way we live publicly has an impact.
 - 2) (Titus 2:7-8) NKJV Paul said...
 - Our lives are a demonstration of good works.
 - 3) (1 Peter 2:12) NLT Peter said...
 - Our conduct is to be honorable among people.

HERE'S THE TAKE AWAY:

- Character is king when *Overcoming Opposition!*

<u>IDEA #2 – DO YOUR PART:</u> (v.18)

1st – God has given us Holy Spirit power to do good (Acts 1:8) NLT.

 2^{nd} – "If it is possible..." (v.18)

- Meaning it's NOT always possible to live peaceably with people.

(Proverbs 29:9) NKJV

(Proverbs 29:27) NKJV

HERE'S THE POINT:

ONCE YOU'VE DONE YOUR PART...

- And if the situation fails...
 - You're to stand back and let God handle it.

<u>IDEA #3 – GOD HAS YOUR BACK:</u> (vv.19-21)

(v.19) Is a partial quote from (Deut. 32:35) NKJV

- Indicating God watches over His people.

*Used by Jonathan Edwards during the 1st Great Awakening (1741).

BUT... PAUL TAKES IT FURTHER IN (v.20)...

- By quoting (Proverbs 25:21-22) NKJV.

The lesson Paul is giving...

- Is how to conduct our lives OUTSIDE the family of faith.

Examples:

- 1) If your enemy is *Hungry*...
 - ➤ Weakness
 - > Emptiness
 - ➤ Lacking
- 2) If your enemy is *Thirsty*...
 - ➤ No purpose
 - Questioning existence
 - ➤ No fulfillment

TURN TO (James 2:14-20) NLT

- Three applications:
 - 1) Faith engages needs (vv.14-16)

- 2) Faith is expressed in outward actions (v.17)
- 3) Faith is prominent in our life (v.18)
