<u>~ INTRO. ~</u>

CATCH THE FLOW WITH ME.

- We're leaving the **dedication** verses...
 - And stepping into the <u>call-to-action</u> verses –Serving God.

LAST WEEK...

- In (vv.1-2) we dealt with the dedication of our lives.

(v.1) Christians are to *present our bodies as living sacrifices*.

- We're to surrender our life to God.

WHY?

BECAUSE... GOD DOESN'T ACCEPT HALF- HEATEDNESS!

SO... PAUL TEACHES THE CHURCH...

- Not to blend into society... by being *conformed to this world*.
- The **world** shapes people from the outside in = *conformed*.
 - The world has a system of life for the here and now.
 - The **world** takes no thought about what's ahead.

AND BEING *conformed* TO THIS **WORLD**...

- Is a death sentence for a Christian!
 - ➤ Because it leaves you empty & desiring more.
 - It's filled with regret & NEVER brings satisfaction.
 - [Solomon proved this in Ecc. 12:13].

ON THE OTHER HAND...

- *Transformation* is a work of the Holy Spirit
 - ➤ That happens from the inside out...
 - o New thoughts and values
 - o New desire to learn from God

"Being transformed"

- Is a cooperative command.
 - ➤ As you **yield to** God's word you're changed.
 - And by **obeying** God's word, the outcome is blessed.

OK... "Next Step"

- From dedication to action.

#1 – MY GIFT

(1 Cor. 15:9-10) NKJV.

- Paul testifies of the GRACE of God given to him...
 - With his wholehearted response.

(v. 3) "a measure of faith"

- Each Christian has been given a correct portion of ability...
 - ➤ For God's purpose a spiritual gift.
- God has given you the exact measure of faith...
 - ➤ To fulfill YOUR part in the body of Christ.
 - o (That's your gift from God.)

#2 – UNDERSTANDING MY GIFT

NOW...

- These spiritual gifts are known as <u>"Motivational Gifts"</u>
 ➤ (vv.6-8)
- The point of these verses IS NOT a complete list of gifts.
 - The point is to identify the GRACE given to you...
 - o (a spiritual gift for service)
 - And use that gift within the church.

TWO PARTS:

- 1) Gifts that **EXPOUND** the word...
 - ➤ *Prophecy* = Declares the truth
 - ➤ *Ministry* = Depicts the truth
 - > Teachers = Define the truth
 - > Exhortation = Stirs you up in the truth
- 2) Gifts that **EXPAND** the word...

- > Giving = Expands the work of the church
- ➤ *Leading* = Organizes the work
- ➤ Mercy = Cares for the people in & around the work

LET'S PUT THESE IN ACTION:

- 1. Prophecy = Speaking forth (public proclamation of the word / truth)
 - ➤ In the OT it was foretelling = predicting the future.
 - ➤ In the NT it's proclaiming what's ALREADY written.
 - o This gift helps people distinguish the truth of God...
 - From cultural values not from God.
- 2. Ministry/Serving = From the same Greek word for deacons...
 - These folks love to help... they practice the truth.
 - They see a need and fill the need.
 - o They jump in & begin working.
- 3. Teachers = Instruct, interpret, clarify, systematize, & explain.
 - > This gift points out principles & gives application.
- 4. Exhorts = Calls other to obey, they drive home truth passionately.

<u>Positive:</u> They encourage, comfort, & strengthen believers.

Negative: They admonish & correct.

- 5. Gives = Sacrificial sharing of resources.
 - ➤ This person does it willingly & generously.
- 6. Leads = Lit. "Standing before"... meaning to guide or steer a ship.
 - > This person points out the way with a specific direction.
- 7. Mercy = Sympathy and sensitivity to those suffering or sorrowful.
 - > They do it with incredible cheerfulness.
 - > Great at doing hospital visits.
 - ➤ This person has a God given ability to sense the needs...
 - o Of hurting people & come alongside with comfort.

#3 – USING MY GIFT

HERE'S THE APPLICATION...

- We're turning this message to you personally – now.

(Eph. 4:16)...

When every part does it's share, it causes growth in the Church.

- The gifting of God is for the service of God.

SO... WHERE...

- Has God's grace gifted you?

OPEN YOUR HEART...

- If you've been here for more than 6-months...
 - > And you're not regularly serving...
 - O You're NOT listen to what God said (Rom 12:1).

THIS PORTION OF ROMANS...

- Allows you to understand your <u>Next Step</u> in following Jesus...
 - > By teaching you to use the gift God has given you.
