#### WE 'VE BEEN EXPLORING...

- The big idea of: Living like a Christian.

#### WE'VE COVERED...

- 1) Living **INSIDE** the family of faith (Rom. 12:9-16).
- 2) Living OUTSIDE the family of faith (Rom. 12:17-21).

- Some *Taboo Topics* (Rom 13).

#### NOW... (Chp. #13) BEGINS...

- By addressing the hardest thing...
  - ➤ We'll ever have to do surrendering control to another.

#### YET...

- That's the first step for everyone that comes to Christ.
  - We're to be <u>subject OR submit</u> ... ourselves to God's will.

# <u>IDEA #1 – SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITIES</u>

#### SCRIPTURE PROVIDES...

- God given institutions we are to be subject to:
  - 1) Government institutions (Rom. 13:1).
  - 2) Family structure (Col. 3:18-20).
  - 3) Church leaders (Heb. 13:17).

# THE **TOPIC** AT HAND... IS BEING SUBMISSIVE...

- And the <u>application</u> is to – governing authorities (v.1).

#### HERE'S A HANDFUL OF TRUTHS...

- We should retain.

## **#1)** Two responsibilities: Matt 22:17-21 (NKJV)

a) Fulfill your obligation to the Government;

b) Fulfill your obligation to God.

## **KEY LESSON:**

- If the two ever collide...
  - We yield to the <u>highest-order</u>... by submitting to God.

#### (Dan. 3:16-18) NKJV

- Shows that we serve & submit to government practices...
  - ➤ Until they violate God's principles.
- (Acts 5:29)...
  - "we ought to obey God rather than men"

#### WHY?

### 1 Kings 10:9b (NLT)

"Because of the LORD's eternal love for Israel, He has made you king so you can rule with justice and righteousness."

## #2) GOD'S INTENT...

- For those with authority – rule with *justice* & *righteousness*.

## 1 Peter 2:13-17 (NLT)

- The **motivation** for submitting to authorities is to **honor God**.
- **#3)** Governing authorities should punish wrong doers.
  - God assigned *capital punishment* to man in (Gen. 9:6) NLT.
- #4) The church can avoid unnecessary wrath...
  - AND avoid a *guilty conscience* by submitting to the government.
    - ➤ Because "... he is God's minister to us for good." (v.4).
- #5) The tax man is also God's *minister* to us.
  - So pay your taxes!
    - ➤ (v.7) NKJV...
      - o *Taxes* = Federal & State
      - $\circ$  *Customs* = Sales tax
      - $\circ$  *Fear* = Respect

#### • *Honor* = Honor & submission

(vv.1-7) Is focused on our *Social Responsibilities* as followers of Christ.

#### **IDEA #2 – MORAL RESPONSIBILITIES**

#### OK...

- Catch the flow as we transition topics...
  - From government institutions...
    - o To people made in the image of God.

#### LOVE...

- Is how we relate to <u>ALL people</u>.
  - > We're NOT to be in default to the government...
    - o And we're NOT to be negligent in...
      - Moral responsibilities!

# <u>LOVE PROMOTES – LO</u>VE PREVENTS

Compassion Harshness
Forgiveness Retaliation
Generosity Selfishness

## IDEA #3 – SPIRITUAL URGENCY

(v.11) *awake out of sleep* = moral carelessness.

## (v.13) IS A SUMMARY OF SIN'S...

- That characterize people who live...
  - ➤ As though Christ is NOT returning.

## There are *six items* OR *three pairs*:

- 1) Wild parties & drunkenness;
- 2) Sexual promiscuity & immoral living;
- 3) Quarreling & jealousy.

#### PAUL'S TEACHING THE CHURCH...

- That these behaviors damage the whole person.

- ➤ Intoxicants lead to a loss of self-control;
- > Unrestrained sex leads to a loss of purity;
- ➤ Relational hostility leads to a <u>loss of unity</u>.

#### LET'S...

- Talk about sexuality for a moment...
  - > Because it's a big deal.

A common N.T. word is "sexual immorality" is (por-ni-ah)

- We get our English word pornography from it.
  - And it's used for all things sexual outside of marriage.
    - o (It carries the idea of "selling off.")

(1 Peter 2:11) NLT

#### WHY DOES THIS MATTER?

Because... sexual immorality is a silent killer (it destroys the soul).

#### HERE'S THE IMPACT:

- It renders a person unfit to enter God's presence.
  - ➤ (Gal. 5:19) uncleanness...
    - o Means: Defiled, foul, ceremonially unfit.

#### CHRISTIAN'S...

- Living in **unrepentant** sexual immorality...
  - > Cannot come into the presence of God.
    - o So this person remains defiled.

#### IT LOOKS LIKE THIS: 1

- 1) It's not wrong to have sex, if we love each other.
- 2) Times have changed, and sex before marriage is not considered sin.
- 3) We're married in God's eyes. He knows were going to get married.
