~ *INTRO* ~

OK... LET'S BEGIN...

- By understanding how God's power is working in us & for us.

(v.17) THE WORD...

- "Righteousness" simply means right clothing.
 - We're clothed in the righteousness of Christ.

WE LOVE TO MEASURE OURSELVES...

- Downward against our fellow man.
 - (I'm doing better than he is... so I must NOT be that bad).
- But the real measurement is alway upward against a Holy God.
 - ➤ (Isa. 6:5) NLT "I am doomed for I am a sinful man..."

(Isa. 64:6) NLT

"We are all infected and impure with sin. When we display our righteous deeds, they are nothing but filthy rags."

THE POINT IN ROMANS IS:

- 1) God is righteous
- 2) God demands righteousness
- 3) God is the one who provides the righteousness
- "The Gospel according to God's Grace."

(Phil 3:9) NLT

"... I no longer count on <u>my own righteousness</u> through obeying the law; rather, <u>I become righteous through faith in Christ</u>. For God's way of making us right with himself depends on faith."

NOW HERE'S A TRANSITION...

- From (v.17) into (v.18)... AND the tone switches gears...
 - From those that walk by faith...
 - o To those that **REFUSE** to walk by faith!

<u>IDEA #1 – THE WRATH OF GOD:</u> (v.18)

A FEW TERMS WE NEED TO UNDERSTAND:

- 1) Un-godliness = Man to God sin (Ex. 20:1-11)
 - ➤ It addresses the thoughts & deeds of man toward God.
 - o It describes a person's attitude & actions that <u>disregard</u> God.
- 2) <u>Un-righteousness</u> = Man to man \sin (Ex. 20:12-17)
 - ➤ Defined as a <u>violation of divine law...</u>
 - Which covers how a person relates to other humans.

PAUL SAYS...

- That God's wrath is reveal against those...
 - > That are stubborn & self-determined...
 - o To do their own thing... their own way!
 - They "suppress the truth"

WHY?

(2 Thess. 2:10)

"... Because they <u>did not receive</u> the love of the truth, that they might be saved."

<u>IDEA #2 – THE LIGHT OF CREATION:</u> (vv.19-20)

GOD HAS AN EXPECTATION...

- For man to *use common sense*... (plain observable knowledge)...
 - ➤ When looking at creation.
 - o (Psalm 19:1-4a) NLT

THERE ARE PEOPLE WHO TRY TO EXPLAIN AWAY GOD...

- By twisting creation!
 - And... man-to-man they may get away with it.
 - o But God says that are *without excuse* (v.20).

(v.19) NLT -

"They know the truth about God because he has made it obvious to them."

IT'S BEEN SAID...

- Napoleon was walking with his generals one night...

- > Discussing the existence of God.
 - o AND as they talked...
 - Napoleon **pointed** to the **stars** and said...

"If you're going to get rid of God, you must get rid of those."

WHEN GOD... IS... DISREGARDED...

- People to do what is right in their own eyes... (Judges 21:25).

<u>IDEA #3 – THE DOWNWARD SPIRAL:</u> (vv.21-23)

Paul continues speaking about the <u>secular-man</u>...

- Who's in need of the Gospel of grace!

(Eph. 4:17-20) NLT

(v.21) They "became futile in their thoughts..."

- Literally: They feel into error...
 - > And produced meaningless conclusions.

(v.22) "They became fools..."

- This is **NOT** speaking of **intellect**.
 - ➤ It's addressing a distorted **moral condition**.

AGAIN... THIS DESCRIBES A PERSON...

- Who has been cultivated into **NOT** believing in god.

(Athiest.org ~ 2018) "If you call yourself a <u>humanist</u>, <u>freethinker</u>, <u>bright</u>, or even a "cultural Catholic" ... you are an atheist."

ON THE OTHER HAND...

The English biologist <u>Thomas Henry Huxley</u> coined the word <u>agnostic</u> in 1869, and said, "It simply means that a man shall not say he knows or believes that which he has no scientific grounds for professing to know or believe."

THIS IS NOT NEW TO THE SCRIPTURES...

- In (Acts 17:23) Paul came into the <u>highest court in Athens</u>...
 - ➤ Known as "the Areopagus" which met next to Mars Hill.

- AND... he spoke to them about the UNKNOWN GOD...
 - ightharpoonup Literal Greek = (Ag-nos-tos) = Unknown
