#### ROMANS...

- "The Gospel According to Grace"

### AS WE UNLOCK THIS FIRST CHAPTER...

- We find that the <u>Good News</u> has transformative power!

## **Paul defined** the Gospel like this:

- *The power of God saving everyone who believes.* (v.16).

## **Leon Morris** – A New Testament Scholar <sup>1</sup>

- Defined the Gospel this way:

"The gospel is not advice to people, suggesting that they lift themselves up. [Rather] it is the very <u>power</u> that lifts them up."

## <u>AI</u> generated response about the Gospel:

"The Christian gospel is not simply a set of guidelines or suggestions for personal improvement, but rather <u>a transformative force</u> that actively empowers individuals to overcome their struggles and achieve spiritual growth through faith in Jesus Christ." <sup>2</sup>

#### **JESUS** SAID:

- (John 8:32) NKJV
  - "... you shall know the truth and the truth shall make you free."

# IDEA#1 – IT'S A GIFT

#### TODAY...

- We recognize it's God's *grace* that gives us God's *peace* (v.7).

# (v.8) PAUL HEARD ABOUT THEIR FAITH...

- Because there was evidence.

#### THE CHRISTIAN LIFE...

- Is started, sustained, & ends ONLY by walking in faith.
  - > AND a genuine faith is an <u>active faith</u>.

## IT'S BEEN SAID... "When the root of salvation is present...

- The fruit of salvation naturally follows."

# **Qualities of Genuine Faith:**

- 1) Faith engages needs (James 2:15-16) NLT
- 2) Faith is expressed in outward actions (James 2:17) NLT
- 3) Faith is prominent in your life (James 2:18) NLT
- 4) Faith flows from the heart (James 2:19-20) NLT ➤ \*(Rom. 10:9) NLT

#### HERE'S THE LESSON...

Accurate theology never replaces an obedient life.

- Otherwise were on the same footing as demons...
  - ➤ (James 2:19-20) NLT

## BACK IN (Rom. 1:8)...

- These people had a fruitful faith... spoken of throughout the world.

# <u>IDEA #2 – GOD'S POWER WORKING IN ME</u>

In (vv.16-17) we could do an entire study.

- But I'm only going to draw out...
  - ➤ <u>Two observations</u> *Salvation & faith*.

## (v.16) GOD OFFERS SALVATION...

- To anyone who will receive it.
  - ➤ And <u>Salvation</u> implies the <u>idea of</u>:
    - Deliverance
    - Safety
    - o Preservation
    - o Healing
    - Soundness

# (Romans 1:7-17) "This Is Transformation"

#### SALVATION COVERS...

- All redemptive acts & processes that GOD offers to man: <sup>3</sup>

### LET ME STREAM-LINE THE TECHNICAL TALK...

- Into three movements:
  - 1) The Christian <u>has been</u> saved from the *guilt & penalty of sin* Justification speaks to our PAST
  - 2) The Christian <u>is being</u> saved from the *habit of sin*Sanctification speaks to our PRESENT
  - 3) The Christian will be saved bodily at the Lords return Glorification speaks to our FUTURE

## ~ IN CLOSING ~

(v.17) "the just shall live by faith"

- *Faith* is involved from beginning to end. It's the only way!
  - We're saved by *faith* 
    - o AND the way we live is by *faith*.

#### CHURCH...

- God doesn't make the sinner a good person.
  - ➤ God treats the sinner...
    - $\circ$  As if he had never sinner at all <u>a new creation!</u>
