## TODAY...

- Let's start with (Ps. 119:130) NLT.
  - > God's wisdom is greater than ours.
    - o And we CAN understand what He's saying to us.

## LAST WEEK WE LEARNED...

- About *Justification* in three ways:
  - 1) Justification is an ACT of God and not earned by man.
  - 2) There's no degrees of justification.
  - 3) God <u>doesn't</u> make us righteous; <u>He</u> declares us righteous.

## NOW... IN (Rom. 4)...

- We learn about *Justification* from *history*.
  - ➤ Thru Abraham the father of faith...
    - And David a man after God's own heart.
- Two well known & respected men in Jewish history.

### ABRAHAM...

- Comes out of (Genesis)... which relates to the <u>books of the Law</u>.

## WHEREAS... DAVID...

- <u>Is known</u> for the book of (Psalms)...
  - ➤ Which is <u>linked with</u> the <u>prophets</u>.

# (Rom 3:21)...

- The <u>law & the prophets</u> were the OT witnesses.
  - > AND <u>Paul uses</u> them <u>to illustrate the harmony</u> of God...
    - o From the OT into the NT.

### JUST LIKE THIS...

- OT = (Mal. 3:6) NKJV
- NT = (Heb. 13:8) NKJV

# <u>IDEA #1 – JUSTIFICATION IS BY FAITH</u>

## IN (Rom. 4)...

- Paul uses the Greek word *Li-Ge-Zo-My* 11-times...
  - ➤ (accounted OR imputed)

### A BANKING TERM FOR...

- 1) **Collecting** credits & debits
- 2) **Totaling** them up
- 3) Placing the balance into an account
  - We understand it as <u>reconciling</u> a bank account.
    - Our sin-debt is greater than we can pay.
      - But Jesus balances our account with a surplus.

## THE TAKE AWAY IS SIMPLE...

- Salvation in the OT & NT is the same... it's "by faith."
- Justification is not a new concept...
  - ➤ Because it goes all the way back to Abraham...
    - o In (Gen. 15:2-6) NKJV.

### PERHAPS...

- You're learning this for this first-time?!?
  - > Yet God has been working on your behalf from the beginning.
    - o That's how great His love for you is.

# **IDEA #2 – JUSTIFICATION IS NOT BY WORKS**

- (v.4) The person **trying to work** for God's approval is skipping God's grace...
  - And messing up the accounting process Li-Ge-Zo-My = Counted.
- (v.5) ABRAHAM...
  - Is the <u>perfect illustration</u> for us...
    - ➤ As God *justifies* a man who wrestles with this concept for 25-yrs.

### LET'S WATCH THIS IN ACTION...

# (Gen. 12:1-4)

- God promised to make Abraham fruitful & give him a child @ 75-yrs old.

# (Gen. 16:1-4 & 15-16)

- Abraham waited about 10-yrs before helping God @ 86-yrs old.
  - ➤ He & his wife (Sarai) agreed to use her maidservant (Hagar)
    - o To have a son (Ismael).
      - But it only created problems for them!

# (Gen 17:1-8)

- At 99-yrs old.
  - ➤ Abraham couldn't physically do anything else...
    - o Then (v.1) God said to him
      - walk before Me and be blameless.

## (Gen. 21:5-7) NKJV

- Finally... at 100-yrs old the promise was received.

### GOD DELAYED...

- Fulfilling the promise...
  - > Until all of Abraham's natural strength ran out.
    - o Until his efforts came to an end & he surrendered.

### GANG...

- We're **prone to add to** God's work... BUT we can't!
- We just need to accept it by faith.
  - ➤ Justification is by faith & not works.

### WHAT IS GOD DELAYING IN YOUR LIFE...

- Because you won't let go?
  - ➤ Because you won't trust Him?

# (Phil. 1:11) NLT

# <u>IDEA #3 – JUSTIFICATION PULLS US OUT OF SIN</u>

### HERE'S AN EXAMPLE OF GOD'S GRACE...

- David remembers when he got stuck in sin (Ps. 32:1-2) NLT.
- When he didn't deal with it... this is what happened (Ps. 32:3-4) NLT.

- But when he confessed it... look what God did (Ps. 32:5) NLT.

## CHURCH...

- Recognize the distinction between...
  - > Our **position** as justified in Christ...
    - And our **condition** as still being prone to sin.
- We're still going to blow it!
  - > BUT we've been declared righteous by grace... thru faith...
    - o And NOT because of works.

## IF YOU'RE CONDEMNED IN SIN THIS MORNING...

- God wants to help you.
