Justification by faith...

- Is what separates *The Good News* of Biblical Christianity...
 - From all other <u>religions</u> in the world.
- God reaching down in love...
 - > Not man working to get to God.

HERE'S WHAT WE'VE LEARNED:

- i. Theologically
 - a) Justification is an ACT of God.
 - b) There's no degrees of justification.
 - c) God <u>doesn't</u> make us righteous; <u>He</u> declares us righteous <u>in Christ</u>.
- ii. *Historically*
 - We saw *Justification* played out...
 - 1) Thru Abraham the father of faith.
 - 2) Thru David a man after God's own heart.
- iii. <u>Practically</u>
 - Justification ELIMINATES...
 - The question of where I stand with God?

(1 John 5:13) NKJV

- Justification is the assurance of your salvation.

POINT #1 – JUSTIFIED BY GRACE ALONE

(vv.9-10) ABRAHAM'S FAITH IN GOD...

- Was accounted to him... before he performed any religious act.

- ➤ He got saved & then he got circumcised.
 - o So the act was an external response to an internal faith.

Romans 4:9-25 "Power In The Promise"

LET ME GIVE YOU AN EXAMPLE – WATER BAPTISM.

- Salvation is a response of faith to the Gospel not the act of baptism.
 - ➤ Water baptism is NOT an act of salvation...
 - o But an act of obedience (1 Peter 3:21) NLT.

CIRCUMCISION...

- Was a sign & seal.
 - \triangleright The <u>sign</u> = Was the external physical act of circumcision.
 - ightharpoonup The <u>seal</u> = Was the internal response of faith to God.

FOR MANY OF THE JEWS...

- Circumcision became **more important** than faith.
 - > It was a tangible act they could grasp & feel good about...
 - o While being totally **separated from** a walk of faith.

HERE'S WHAT WE'RE TO UNDERSTAND:

- External observances for salvation are completely <u>meaningless</u>.
 - ➤ I'm saved by grace thru faith (Eph. 2:8) NKJV.

IF EXTERNAL ACTIVITY...

- Is the basis of my faith...
 - ➤ Then I'm <u>relating</u> to God <u>by keeping rules</u>...
- And I've <u>alienated myself</u> from <u>grace</u>.

IDEA #2 – JUSTIFIED BY GOD NOT HUMAN EFFORT

(v.17) is a key to faith...

"God, who gives life to the dead"

NOTICE THERE'S...

- No human effort that can come from a dead guy.
 - ➤ God is the only source of life.

BE CAREFUL...

- That you don't begin to live with <u>self-imposed righteousness</u>... (I have to keep this / I have to keep that / or I'm not right!)

Romans 4:9-25 "Power In The Promise"

PEOPLE WANT THE

- New covenant for salvation...
 - And the **old covenant** for sanctification...
 - Because they get to do something to earn grace NO!

(Gal. 5:4) NKJV...

- Paul calls this condition, "Fallen from grace."
 - > Not fallen from salvation...
 - o But fallen from the sphere of God's blessing.
- We don't become holy by obeying God's law in our own power.
 - > It is **only BY** yielding to the Holy Spirit by faith.

SO...

- Why did God establish the principals of righteousness by faith?
