TODAY...

- We close (Rom. 5) on the topic of "Federal Headship."

IN THEOLOGY Federal Headship...

- Helps us understand how Adam's sin spread to all people.

LET ME ILLUSTRATE IT THIS WAY:

WHEN WE VOTE IN NATIONAL ELECTIONS...

- Our vote sends representatives to Washington D.C. on our behalf.
 - Elected Officials then make decisions & the consequences...
 - o Filter down to the rest of the country.

SO TOO...

- Adam was the first representative of *the human race*.
 - ➤ <u>His decision</u> to sin against God...
 - o Separated everyone else from God...
 - AND sin entered the world.

READ >>> (Rom. 5:12-21)

<u>IDEA #1 – THE ORGIN & RESULT OF SIN</u>

1) The Origin of Sin:

- a) Sin entered the *universe* thru Satan... (Ezk. 28:15-17).
- b) Sin entered the *world* thru Adam... (Gen. 3:6-8).
- c) The **root of sin** comes from Adam... (Rom. 5:12).

(1 John 1:8) NKJV

Romans 5:12-21 "Understanding My Choice"

"If we say that we have <u>no sin</u> we deceive ourselves, & the truth is not in us"

- We're **born** with the ROOT of sin **in us**.

(v.12) "because all sinned"

- Paul is NOT speaking of a sinful act...
 - ➤ He's speaking of universal guilt in the headship of Adam.
- d) The **fruit of sin** comes from us individually.

2) **Result of Sin**:

- Turn to (Gen. 5) this is the **genealogy of Adam**...
 - > Showing the repeating result of sin = "and he died."

Man is NOT a sinner because he sinned.

He's a sinner because he's born that way and therefore sins.

IDEA #2 – WHICH REPRESENTATIVE DO YOU WANT?

(vv.13-17)...

- Paul gives an in-depth explanation of (v.12).

(vv.13-14)

SIN WAS NOT <u>IMPUTED</u> – (Li-Ge-Zo-My)...

- But it was present from Adam to Moses – *before the law*.

(v.13)...

- Sin was in the world but not **imputed** (not added to my ledger).
 - > So the law was given to show man's need for God.
 - o (I'm living in a moral <u>deficit</u> to God)

(Gal 3:24)

"...the law was our tutor to bring us to Christ, that we might be justified by faith."

ADAM'S SIN...

- Was a representative act...
 - ➤ AND the consequences of his sin <u>are passed to all.</u>

Romans 5:12-21 "Understanding My Choice"

NOW THIS IS IMPORTANT!

- Paul carves out the contrast & arrives at a conclusion:
- (v.15) Adam committed an offense (vs.) Christ gave a free gift.
- (v.16) Adam leads to condemnation (vs.) Christ to justification.
- (v.17) In Adam death reigns (vs.) in Christ life reigns.

Show this verse on screen $\gg (v.17)$ NLT

IDEA #3 – JUDGEMENT OR FREE GIFT

GOD MADE THE OPTIONS CLEAR...

- Man is condemned on three grounds:
 - 1) Sinful nature inherited from Adam (root of sin).
 - 2) Sinful practices actions & attitudes (fruit of sin).
 - 3) Condemnation for rejecting Christ who offers (forgiveness of sin).

(v.20) "where sin abounded grace abounds much more..."

~ IN CLOSING ~

God offers grace to help us in four ways:

- 1) To **ACCEPT** the love of God & have your sins forgiven (Rom. 10:9)
- 2) To **CONFESS** that you've become <u>lukewarm</u> toward God (Rev. 3:15)
- 3) To **TRUST** Him and be assured of your salvation (1 John 5:13)
- 4) To **RECEIVE** power from God's Holy Spirit (Acts 8:15)
