





Rise and Walk: The Trial and Triumph of Dennis Byrd Wednesday, July 13, 2022 6—8 PM

Men of all ages are invited to join us for our men's summer book club, affectionately dubbed "BBQ and a Book." We'll gather at someone's house, enjoy good food, and each other's company as we discuss our thoughts on the inspirational book, "Rise and Walk: The Trial and Triumph of Dennis Byrd." If you are interested, please secure a copy of the book, read it, and join us on July 13. Please register and then you'll be given the address for the BBQ gathering. All men are invited! The book can be purchased on Amazon thru the link on our sites.

Byrd, a defensive lineman for the New York Jets, was paralyzed from the neck down in a collision during a game in November 1992. This book provides a full autobiographical treatment of the 27-year-old Byrd, but its essence is a graphic, arresting description of the physical and emotional devastation he experienced from the moment of impact to the present time. The strenuous work undertaken during his recovery is detailed, as are Byrd's spiritual reflections. In a matter of months, Byrd defied all predictions and reasonable hopes and began walking again. He relates the role played by his wife, family, friends, doctors, therapists, and the general public; a combination of "medicine and miracles, of divine love and human faith and, yes, of endless hours of sweat, and pain and tears." This is a very moving and inspirational title that will be of interest primarily to school and public libraries. - John Maxymuk, Rutgers Univ. Lib., Camden, N.J.
