West Lawn is partnering with Help Build Hope to build house frame walls through hosting a local mission project in our parking lot on October 13-14, 2023. During this event, we will essentially build the frame structure for a small house, that will then be given to a family in need to achieve affordable home ownership. The walls we build will provide a way to reduce cost for Habitat for Humanity and Fuller Centers for Housing and allow them to completely finish the homes faster.

We invite everyone, regardless of age, experience or expertise, to help with the build. We are seeking 120 volunteers to serve over the course of the two days. Here's how you can help:

# Cut Session Volunteers - Friday, October 13 - 5:30-8 PM

25-30 adults to assist with cutting the material for a one-house build event. Tasks include operating power saws, measuring and cutting accurate measurements, labeling the cut lumber, carrying the lumber to the appropriate areas, attach vinyl to plates.

# Build Day Crew Leaders - October 13 - 5:30-8 PM & October 14 - 8-11 AM

Crew leaders that have framing experience or are trained by the Help Build Hope staff are needed for this role. The time commitment would be one hour after the cut session on Friday and the duration of the build event on Saturday.

# Build Day Volunteers - Saturday, October 14 - 8-11 AM

We need 75 volunteers to assemble the walls.

# Loading Volunteers - Saturday, October 14 - 12-1 PM

20 volunteers to disassemble and load the house. Ability to lift heavy objects required.

# Hospitality - Saturday, October 14 - 8-11 AM

This team will help our volunteers stay hydrated and fed throughout Saturday morning.
