Dear West Lawn Family,

During my childhood the celebration of Easter always included the Sunrise Service at Capon Chapel Church of the Brethren. The church was located by a bridge on a dirt road in the hills of West Virginia. Unlike our church building, Capon Chapel was one room with a center aisle and raised chancel. The pews were made of flat boards with no cushions. I remember the gas stove situated near the front on the right side of the room and how it always failed to warm the air trapped under the pews on those chilly Easter mornings. It was always dark and cold as the service began, my sleepy eyes and empty belly were never quite prepared and I longed to return to the warm bed at my grandmother's house.

However, the darkness, the cold air, the uncomfortable seating and my hunger pangs never had the last word on Easter Sunday mornings. It wasn't long until the first light reached over the mountain, across the field and through a window above the gas stove. Singing "Up From the Grave He Arose" somehow conquered the chill in the air, and the smell of bacon frying in the back room signaled the end of my hunger as breakfast would be served in the sanctuary following the service. Easter Sunday began cold, dark and hungry and would end amid the laughter and joy of Easter baskets and egg hunts.

Likewise, death and the cold dark tomb would not have the last word for Jesus on that first Easter morning. The last word for Jesus seems to be, "Do not be afraid." With Jesus, there is always another day, another opportunity, another gift of life. We move out of Lent with a greater conviction, less fear, more hope, greater faith. And what about Love? What do we feel for the One who gave all so that we might have all? If our love has grown, how will we express that toward others? "Do not be afraid" of the challenge of the Gospel. God's love for you is greater than all temptations, pitfalls and darkness. Let Easter not be the end of Lent, but the beginning of new challenges with life in Christ, … for Christ is Risen!

Saturday, August 5, 2023 at 6:05 PM versus the Kansas City Royals.


We have two Klein buses reserved, and our own John Coakley will be one of our drivers!


When Mother Nature does not provide, we improvise! Our "Snow Much Fun" indoor gathering for our age 6 and under friends, along with their parents and family members, was great!


