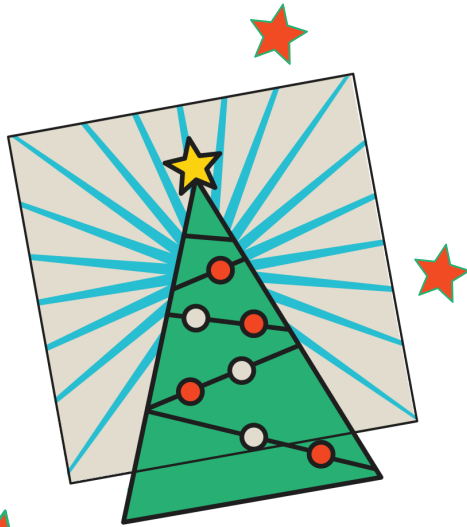

heard that's good?)

for us not just at Christmas, but
every day."

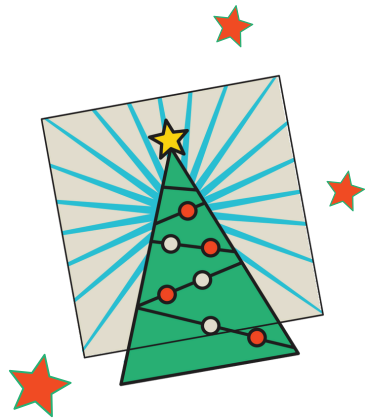

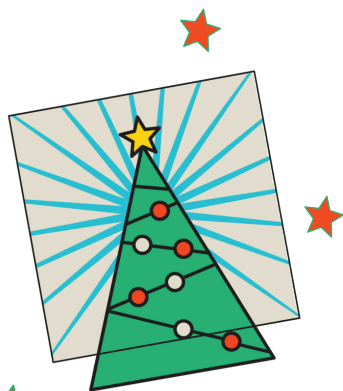
