



My Stephen Ministry Experience by Karen Guers

Back in 2003, Pastor Sherry Lantz introduced Stephen Ministry to the West Lawn UMC congregation. Caring for others was a way of life for me as I was a working nurse and also a mother. So, I was immediately interested in this program, and I really liked the one-to-one aspect of this caring ministry - working with one person at a time. Eventually, I became part of the very first class of 13 participants to go through the 50 hours of Stephen Ministry training. The classes were fun, and I made 11 new friends! My husband, John, was also part of the class.

After attending training, each Stephen Minister is matched to a person needing care (care receiver). With my nursing background, I've had several care receivers with serious illnesses. As a Stephen Minister, I was with them for emotional and spiritual support, listening to them and encouraging their faith, and praying for, and with them.

The amazing part of many of these relationships is how much I have gained, and been given, as the result of the time spent in the company of these care receivers. Sometimes it's a commitment of several months, but it can also be years that you are needed in a care receiver's life. Officially, the relationship will eventually end, but I have made life-long friends through this ministry.

The Stephen Ministry program here at West Lawn UMC is strong. If you think you need a Stephen Minister, or know someone who you think would benefit by having one, please reach out to Pastor Lisa or another Stephen Ministry leader. And if you think you may have an interest in becoming a Stephen Minister, go for it! You will get back so much more than you give.



West Lawn United Methodist Church Leadership Team voting members consists of twelve elected members serving three-year rotating terms, three Lay Members to the Annual Conference, Lay Leader(s) and a Youth Representative. The team reviews major WLUMC policies and objectives, affirms and supports our pastors, reviews the availability of adequate resources, approves the annual budget, including staff compensation, and ultimately is accountable to the congregation for WLUMC's performance. The Leadership Team has six committees that focus specifically on Property, Missions, Personnel, Nominations, Policy & Procedures, and Finance, along with a Facilities Study Committee to examine expansion options.

The following are the major activities the Leadership Team was involved in during 2022:

- Prayerfully work with pastors and staff;
- Provided support to pastors and staff for the additional efforts needed to migrate through the continued challenges presented by the pandemic;
- Continue to witness exceptional staff innovation and creativity in worship and programming;
- Assist with personnel policy;
- Analyze attendance and giving trends;
- Discuss facility options and gather Township input led by a Facilities Study Committee;
- Oversee budgeting;
- Support the Missions Ministry in Peru, West Virginia, and Reading;
- Oversee the renovation of the 100 Woodside property to be used as multi-purpose meeting space;
- Proactively involved in providing for a smooth transition from the retirement of our long-term Senior Pastor, Jeff Raffauf, and welcoming our new Senior Pastor and his wife, Tom and Kimm Ebersole;
- Open monthly meetings with scripture-based devotions to further seek God's guidance.






Patricia Herbst (joined 1/8/2023)


