The Next Chapter

One of my favorite pastimes is reading. When I'm not paging through books for "work," I thoroughly enjoy reading both fiction and nonfiction. I enjoy a poignant memoir, but particularly like nonfiction related to the American Revolution – the historical figures, concepts, battles, and rousing stories of fortitude. On the other hand, if I'm in a fiction kind of mood, I prefer to read speculative works, especially those in the science fiction and fantasy realm.

The most recent book that I've read was *The Day of the Triffids* (1951) by English author John Wyndham. It's a post-apocalyptic story where most people in the world are blinded by an apparent meteor shower and then an aggressive, invasive species of plants (triffids) starts killing people. The book is a real page-turner; one that I couldn't put down and completed in less than a week. The story provoked introspection and reflection upon our present society and its moral choices related to science. Who would have thought that killer plants could provide such a vehicle for contemplation?!

Like any good work of literature, each page adds to the story. As a reader, we're captivated by the dynamic imagination of the author, delighted at what has happened, and eagerly anticipate what is going to happen next. At times, we're surprised and sometimes shocked. We may find ourselves laughing, or crying, or even disappointed at some of the characters and outcomes of the story. All of these emotions and plot twists take us to a different place in our minds than where we were.

Along those same lines, as a church here at West Lawn UMC, we're experiencing the turning of the page, the closing of a chapter, and moving on to the "next chapter," so to speak. Just as before Reverend Jeff Raffauf began his tenure at West Lawn UMC, there were previous pastors in which the church was led in ministry, chapters that laid the foundation for our present setting. And now as the page turns from Pastor Jeff to the "next chapter" that is Reverend Tom Ebersole, I'm excited to see where the story of God's people here at West Lawn UMC will build off of the previous chapters of excitement, suspense, heartbreak, and redemption. The story of our church is a compelling adventure that is truly a page-turner as we have engaged in meaningful worship, fruitful ministries, and transformational mission... and will continue to do so! Where will God lead us? I'm not entirely sure, but I'm eager to find out as we turn the page.

Welcome Pastor Tom & Kimm Ebersole!

Join us for worship Sunday, July 3rd as we welcome Rev. Tom Ebersole and his wife Kimm. They have been married for 36 years and have two grown sons, Cole, and Ross. Kimm and Tom have known each other since childhood and grew up together in Chambersburg, Pennsylvania. Their common ground was the Chambersburg Fourth Street Church of the Brethren where they married in 1985.

Tom graduated from Penn State University in 1987 with a B.S. in Earth and Mineral Sciences. Kimm is a registered nurse with a BSN from Bloomsburg University. She also holds a Masters in Healthcare Administration from Villanova University. Following college, the Ebersoles moved to the Philadelphia area where Tom pursued a career in the environmental industry. Kimm worked as an CICU

nurse at the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania and later as the Director of Quality Management at a Philadelphia based HMO. In 1992, Kimm founded a Wayne-based healthcare consulting firm which Tom joined in 1994.

After attending Wayne United Methodist for ten years, Tom accepted the call to ministry and started seminary studies in the Spring of 2001. One year later he was appointed pastor at Valley Forge United Methodist and remained there for 6 years. In 2003 he attended the UM Northeast Jurisdiction Local Pastors Licensing School at Drew University, and in May of 2008 completed a Masters in Divinity at Palmer Theological Seminary in Wynnewood, PA. In August of 2008 Tom was appointed full-time to Messiah United Methodist in Lafayette Hill, PA. At Annual Conference, May 2010, Tom was ordained as an Elder in the United Methodist Church.

In 2015 the Ebersoles sold the family business and Tom returned with Kimm to Wayne United Methodist Church as lead pastor where he served until accepting the Bishop's appointment to West Lawn United Methodist. Today, Kimm works with a legal healthcare consulting firm as Director of Marketing and Compliance. Both Tom and Kimm are excited to join the West Lawn Church family in ministry.

National Night Out is 8/2/22

National Night Out is a community-police awareness-raising event in the United States, held on the first Tuesday of August.

The event has been held annually since 1984, and is sponsored by the National Association of Town Watch in the United States which began simply with neighbors turning on their porch lights and sitting in front of their homes. The first National Night Out involved 2.5 million residents across 400 communities in 23 states; National Night Out 2016 involved 38 million residents in 16,000 communities across the United States.

The event is meant to increase awareness about police programs in communities, such as drug prevention, town watch, neighborhood watch, and other anti-crime efforts.

West Lawn UMC will once again be present at this year's National Night Out on Tuesday, August 2nd. This event will take place at the Lincoln Park Pool from 5-9 PM. We will be there representing our church handing out goodies and greeting the hundreds of guests that come to this family fun evening at the pool. 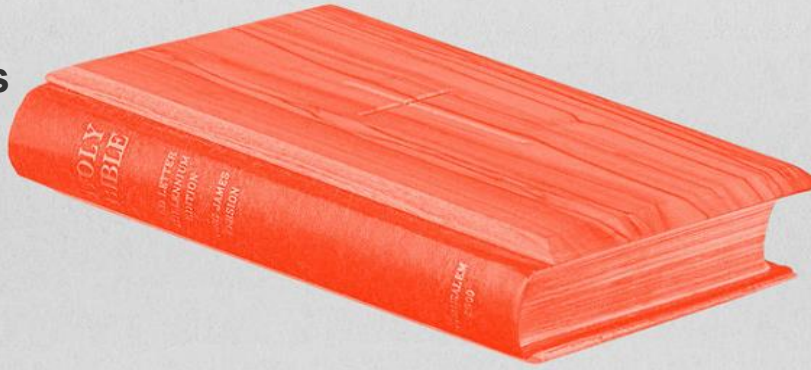

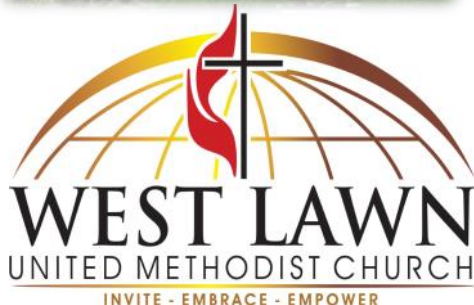
