

On Sunday, May 22nd we celebrated our 110th Anniversary Sunday! Thanks to Scott Wyrick, who submitted some old photographs, I had the privilege of sharing some of our church history in story and pictures. It is a grand history, and I have delighted over the years to share it often: in Sunday school or worship, at Inquirers' Classes, and whenever anyone would ask! (You can see the photos by going to Livestream on our app or website and replaying the sermon, "Faithful: Past, Present & Future.")

The story of a church can easily become a story of bricks and mortar. I often talk about our different building eras:

- 1913 first wooden church structure opened at Penn & Woodside Avenues
- 1927 first brick church was built; what is now the flat-ceilinged portion of our present sanctuary
- 1957 pitched-roof section of our sanctuary built, with a dug-out basement for Sunday school space
- 1967 cornerstone laid for our education building, now known as the Reiner Education Building
- 1987 major renovation of the sanctuary, balcony, basement, and stained-glass doors & elevator added
- 2007 a newly renovated Community Center was opened for ministry
- 2017 or 2018 100 Woodside property was added

This is all good stuff, and important for us to remember, and cause for us to give thanks to God!

However, bricks and mortar, and parking lot additions, are only part of our story! The real evidence of the movement of the Holy Spirit is seen in the lives of God's People. As much as I enjoy retelling the story of our church to Inquirers, I *really* love telling of the many ministries in which our church is engaged and the ways people's lives are impacted through this place. I get *really* excited talking about:

SafeHaven Lighthouse – a laity-dreamed, lay driven afterschool program that began in 2001, and is intended to give children a safe place to be during the hours of 3 and 6 p.m. when elementary aged children so often fall to temptations.

West Lawn Wednesdays – also dating back to 2001, WLW and the Community Meal began with a desire to give our people, who worship in different services, a place to gather and mingle. It has become so much more! Families come together, people of all ages can be fed spiritually as well as physically, youth provide community service, the lonely find dinner companions, and food is prepared for those in need. This "Food for the Body – Food for the Soul" ministry is one of those for which I am most proud.

Mission Trips – while this may appear to be a "bricks and mortar" activity, the emphasis these past 22 years has been of the transformation of lives – both those we serve and the lives of those who serve. I am so proud of our people who serve their "neighbors near and far" through mission work teams.

Christmas Miracle Offering – I don't know how we could tell the story of West Lawn's past 2 decades without mentioning the loving, giving spirit evidenced by our Christmas Miracle Offering received each year from 2012 through 2021. In those 10 years we have received and given away (actually invested!) \$766,115.87 in life-changing ministries and with mission partners. This congregation has proven again and again that we know how to celebrate Jesus' birthday, and we take seriously the commandment to Love Our Neighbors! Thank you to each one who has ever given to the CMO. You have done a world of good, in Jesus' name.

I could go on and on, but I won't – you wouldn't want to read it anyway! Suffice it to say that I have been abundantly blessed to be your Lead Pastor these 22 years. For the opportunity to officiate at nearly 250 weddings, celebrate 380 baptisms, comfort those who mourn at 400 funerals, and receive into members nearly 1,300 new members, more than half by Profession of Faith, I thank you!

Praise be to God, who has been so faithful to me and to us, past – present – and future!






