JOURNEY OF A LIFETIME

Life is a journey. That's no surprise to you! Many, if not most of us, have seen how life can unfold in various chapters. We grow up. We prepare for our future. We meet people, maybe marry, perhaps have children, and we make decisions! Career decisions. Family decisions. Faith decisions.

Our spiritual lives are a journey, as well. On March 2nd we will begin a journey within our journey, if you will. March 2nd is Ash Wednesday, the first day of our annual Lenten Journey. It marks the beginning of a time of spiritual preparation for believers to grow in discipleship. Lent provides us with an intentional period for introspection and, hopefully, growth to become more like Jesus each day.

We have tried to set the stage for such growth through our times together in worship. We began this new year by talking about the Five Marks of Discipleship, based on John Wesley's "Marks of a Methodist." In case you forgot, a disciple or follower of Jesus (1) loves God, (2) rejoices in God, (3) gives thanks, (4) prays constantly, and (5) loves others. If you missed any of those messages, or simply want a refresher, you can find and listen to them on our website or app.

Following our Five Marks of Discipleship, we spent February discussing how we, as believers, are to deal with our significant relationships: with God, with our Significant Other, with others, and with ourselves. These two series, we hope, can help every believer to build a life on the solid foundation of life in God.

Next up is our Lenten sermon series, A Jesus-Shaped Life! It is inspired by a "40 days" devotional book by pastor/author Steve Cordle, founding pastor of Crossroads Church, which has 5 locations in the Pittsburgh area. (Quotes below are from Steve Cordle.) Through the 6 Sundays in Lent we will look at:

March 6, MADE FOR THIS – "If you are a follower of Jesus, there is another force at work in your life – the power of the Holy Spirit. He is shaping you into the image of Jesus!"

March 13, THE OBEDIENCE OF JESUS – "We are all tempted to say, 'I know a shortcut,' to God's directions in our lives. There is a name for those shortcuts: sin. And Jesus told us it doesn't end well. Rule-keeping is not God's aim; transformation is his intent."

March 20, THE RELATIONSHIPS OF JESUS – "Becoming like Jesus means taking on some of his traits and characteristics. There is one trait of Jesus that rises to the top of them all: love. Christlikeness shows up as love."

March 27, THE COURAGE OF JESUS – "We might think our lives would be changed if we had more friends, more money, or less stress. Transformation comes from changing our minds, not from changing our circumstances. A Jesus-shaped life requires a Jesus-shaped mind."

April 3, THE JUSTICE OF JESUS – "Justice won't be complete or perfect until Jesus returns. We will always have to live with some unfairness and injustice until then. That doesn't mean we shrug our shoulders and accept it. Love acts."

April 10 (Palm Sunday, THE MISSION OF JESUS – "If God created a poster, if might have a picture of people and read, 'LOST: My prize creation. Looks something like me; they wandered off and may look beaten up and hungry.' Many people do not have a relationship with God – living as if he doesn't exist. Jesus is looking for his people, and we get to be part of the search party."

As my ministry here as the Lead Pastor at West Lawn draws to a close, I hope my time will be remembered for passionately encouraging God's people to be, talk and act more like Jesus every day. I hope you will join us in worship, in-person or online, EACH SUNDAY this Lenten season, as explore what it means to live a Jesus-Shaped Life.

Please join us on Wednesday evenings, beginning March 16, from 6:00-8:00 in the Reiner Education Building, room 109.




