

Welcome!

Welcome to the Nursery at West Lawn UMC! We are privileged to minister to the youngest members of our church family in our safe, clean, newly-renovated space, under the care of our well-trained and nurturing staff.

Located in Room 101 of the Reiner Education Building, our nursery is a busy and vibrant place for infants through 3-year olds. The rooms are complete with toddler appropriate toys and books, as well as furnishings for babies, including swings, bouncy chairs, exersaucers and more. A changing table and rocking chairs are available for anyone's use. The Nursery is open on Sundays between 7:45 AM-12:30 PM.

> Our Nursery is also open on Wednesday nights, from 6:15-8:00 PM, during Adult Bible studies and Small Group gatherings.



Each week, parents drop off their children in our secure fover where they sign in and take a beeper for easy communication. From there, the children are ushered inside for a fun-filled time of free play, Bible songs and stories, activities and a snack. There are plenty of arms to hold the little ones, and our 2-year-olds are also briefly taken upstairs to participate in the Sunday School opening, songs and an activity.

Mother's Room

New moms and nursing moms - we have made a space just for you and your little one! If you need a quiet spot to feed your baby, or just need a place to retreat for a few minutes, we have you covered! This room is located directly across the hall from our Nursery (in the Reiner Education Building) and you can pick up keys at the Welcome Center or the Nursery.

Our Nursery Staff

Our loving and nurturing Nursery staff is dedicated to caring for your little one. A team of five paid childcare providers, most of them moms themselves, work in the nursery on a rotating basis each Sunday morning. An additional 15 volunteers assist this team. These helpers are trained to respond to emergencies, as well as lend a listening ear, warm smile and calming embrace to the babies and toddlers.



Toddlers receive their first Bible from West Lawn when they turn two. As they grow, they also receive a Bible when entering Third Grade, and again at the beginning of Confirmation Class, in Eighth Grade.
