THE SERVING TABLE:

YOUR SEAT COMES WITH A CALLING

OPENING THOUGHT

At God's table, we're not just FED — we're FORMED.

Jesus invites us close so He can shape our hearts, adjust our motives, reset our direction, and align our spirits with His. Every believer has a seat at God's table, but every seat comes with a calling.

SCRIPTURE FOCUS

John 13:12–15 (NLT)

12 After washing their feet, he put on his robe again and sat down and asked,

“Do you understand what I was doing?”

13 You call me ‘Teacher’ and ‘Lord,’ and you are right, because that’s what I am.

14 And since I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you ought to wash each other’s feet.

15 I have given you an example to follow. Do as I have done to you.”

Ephesians 2:10 (NIV)

“For we are God’s workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.”

WARM-UP QUESTION

Share a moment when someone’s kindness or service encouraged you or lifted you.
How did it shape your day... or even your life?

DISCUSSION POINT 1 — THE TABLE FORMS US

The Table of the Lord is where Jesus forms our:

- Hearts • Motives
- Direction • Spirit

When our hearts are formed, serving doesn't feel heavy — it feels hopeful. It becomes a joy, not a burden.

Discussion:

Which of these areas is God shaping in you right now — heart, motives, direction, or spirit?

DISCUSSION POINT 2 — JESUS SHOWED US THE WAY

Jesus didn't teach about serving from a distance — He demonstrated it by taking a towel and washing feet. Real maturity, fulfillment, and purpose come when we live beyond ourselves.

Discussion:

What part of Jesus' example in John 13 speaks to you most?

DISCUSSION POINT 3 — SERVING AS A SPIRITUAL LAW

Serving isn't just a good idea — it's a Kingdom principle. Jesus showed that those who give their lives away find life overflowing.

There is a simple spiritual pattern:

Serving → Joy

Serving → Blessing

Serving → Growth

Serving → Promotion in God's Kingdom

This law isn't pressure — it's invitation.

Discussion:

What encourages you most about seeing serving as something that brings joy and growth?

DISCUSSION POINT 4 — YOUR STORY HAS POWER

Your story — your experiences, your breakthroughs, your healing — is part of what you bring to the table. When you share it, someone else finds courage.

Discussion:

Is there a part of your story God might use to strengthen someone else?

BREAKOUT — 2–3 PEOPLE

Discuss together:

“Where do I sense God calling me to serve right now?”

Encourage one another. Pray short, hopeful prayers.

GROUP PRAYER

“Jesus, thank You for inviting us to Your table. Thank You for shaping our hearts and strengthening our lives. Show us where You want us to serve, and fill us with joy as we say yes. Make us more like You — the One who loved by serving. Amen.”

CHAMPION PRACTICE FOR THE WEEK

Choose one person or area where you can serve intentionally this week.

Pray daily:

“Lord, form my heart to serve like You.”

PUNTO 2 — JESÚS NOS MOSTRÓ EL CAMINO

Jesús dio el ejemplo al lavar los pies de los discípulos. Servir nos lleva a la madurez y propósito.

Discusión:

¿Qué parte del ejemplo de Jesús te habla más?

PUNTO 3 — SERVIR COMO LEY ESPIRITUAL

Servir es un principio del Reino:

Servicio → Gozo

Servicio → Bendición

Servicio → Crecimiento

Servicio → Promoción

Discusión:

¿Qué te anima al ver que servir trae gozo y crecimiento?

PUNTO 4 — TU HISTORIA TIENE PODER

Tu historia puede dar fuerza a otros.

Discusión:

¿Qué parte de tu historia podría usar Dios para bendecir a alguien?
