WHAT IS ADULT FORMATION? –

Starting in the fall, St. James will be offering weekly Adult Formation at 10 am each Sunday between our two worship services. If you have been wondering, Adult Formation is an adult-focused education, aimed at deepening one's relationship with God and the Christian faith. It includes various practices, such as study, prayer, fellowship, and service, all aimed at fostering spiritual growth.

This fall, the Rev. Valerie Webster and Rev. Lynne Matthews are coordinating for Adult Formation at St. James and will lead an offering called "Studying and Praying with Scripture" most weeks this fall based on that week's lectionary text, with visits from other St. James clergy. Pastor Valerie and Father Greg Smith are planning a series on the celebration of the 1700th Anniversary of the Nicene Creed for the winter (325-2025 C.E.).

"Studying and Praying with Scripture" Adult Formation will be offered on Sundays between services at 10am in the Guild Room and supplemented by monthly book study groups, usually on Friday evenings.
