

Before long Joseph was on his way to Egypt in a parade of camels. But God cared for Joseph wherever he went.


What did Jacob give to his son Joseph?

What happened to Joseph?




Fun or Scary

Cinnamon Toast Hearts

Joseph and his brothers probably took food to eat while they were watching their sheep. Here's a snack you can eat while doing a job at home.

You will need

bread ½ teaspo butter 2 tablesp measuring spoons heart co plastic knife napkin o

toaster oven

½ teaspoon cinnamon 2 tablespoons sugar heart cookie cutter napkin or paper plate air-tight container

What to do

- 1. Ask an adult to help you toast a slice of bread.
- 2. Mix together the cinnamon and sugar and store in an air-tight container.
- 3. Butter the toasted bread. Sprinkle some of the cinnamon and sugar mixture on it.
- 4. Cut the bread with a heart-shaped cookie cutter.

As you eat your snack, thank God that He cares for you.



As a child, were you afraid of the dark, certain animals, or shadows in the

closet? How did you respond to your fears?

You can help your children understand their fears and grow in their ability to overcome those fears. First, recognize your child's fears—no matter how silly or small they seem to you. Read books to your child with stories of kids who have experienced similar fears. Talk and pray about the fears.

The Bible talks about fear and reminds us that perfect love drives out fear. (1 John 4:18). We must encourage children to be confident of God's love. He cares for us all the time.
