Peter Preaches About Jesus

Acts 1:12-14; 2:1-8, 14, 22-24, 36-42

Bible Memory Verse: "We cannot help speaking about what we have seen and heard." ~ Acts 4:20

Supplies for this lesson: Pencil, crayons/markers

Now that we have learned about a bunch of amazing things that happened when Jesus was on Earth, we're going to turn our attention to what happened after Jesus went back to Heaven. This is the time when Jesus' followers began meeting together without Jesus, usually in people's homes. Eventually the church as we know it today was created out of these meetings, but that didn't happen for many years. In our lesson today, the word "church" refers to all the people who believed in and followed Jesus, not any one particular congregation.

Every day we make choices. Some of them are good choices and some of them are bad choices. Read each of the situations below and decide if a good or bad choice was made:

- 1. Bobby's Mom asked him to take out the trash but Bobby decided to keep playing video games instead.
- 2. A little girl in Anne's class fell on the playground. The other kids ignored her but Anne helped her up and walked with her to the nurse's office.
- 3. Donna's Mom told her not to eat any more candy but Donna snuck the whole bag while her Mom wasn't watching and ate the whole thing. Later she had a very bad stomach ache.
- 4. Sam's friends wanted him to play baseball with them, but his little brother was sick and sad about being left alone. Sam chose to stay home and play Legos with his little brother.

After Jesus went to Heaven, people had to choose whether they would follow His ways. The people who did became part of the church. They did what Jesus did and what He told them to do, including telling others about Him. We can make the same choice – we can be part of the church.

Next, find this week's Activities page at the end of this lesson plan and print it out. Turn to page 21. Read the summary of today's Bible story and answer the questions. The people who obeyed and followed Jesus became part of the church. We can be part of the church too.

Today we learned that many people became part of the church on the Day of Pentecost (That's what the church calls the day the Holy Spirit came to Jesus' followers in Jerusalem). For our next activity, let's think about some things the church does today and how we can be part of that. Turn to page 22 of your Activities page. Read the instructions for completing the activity. What kinds of things does your church do? We can meet together and read from God's word, the Bible. We can sing and praise God. We can take Communion and remember Jesus. We can share what we have and serve others in Jesus' name. We can be part of the church.

Another way we can be part of the church is to share what we know about God with others, by telling them about Jesus. For our last activity today, print the activity page called I Can Tell About Jesus from the end of this lesson plan. In each box, draw a picture of or write about a place where you can share the good news about Jesus with others.

Well done! Let's end our lesson this week with a prayer for the church everywhere.

Prayer:

Dear God, thank You that we can be part of the church. Help everyone around the world who is part of the church choose to do what Jesus did and said to do. In Jesus' name we pray, amen.


